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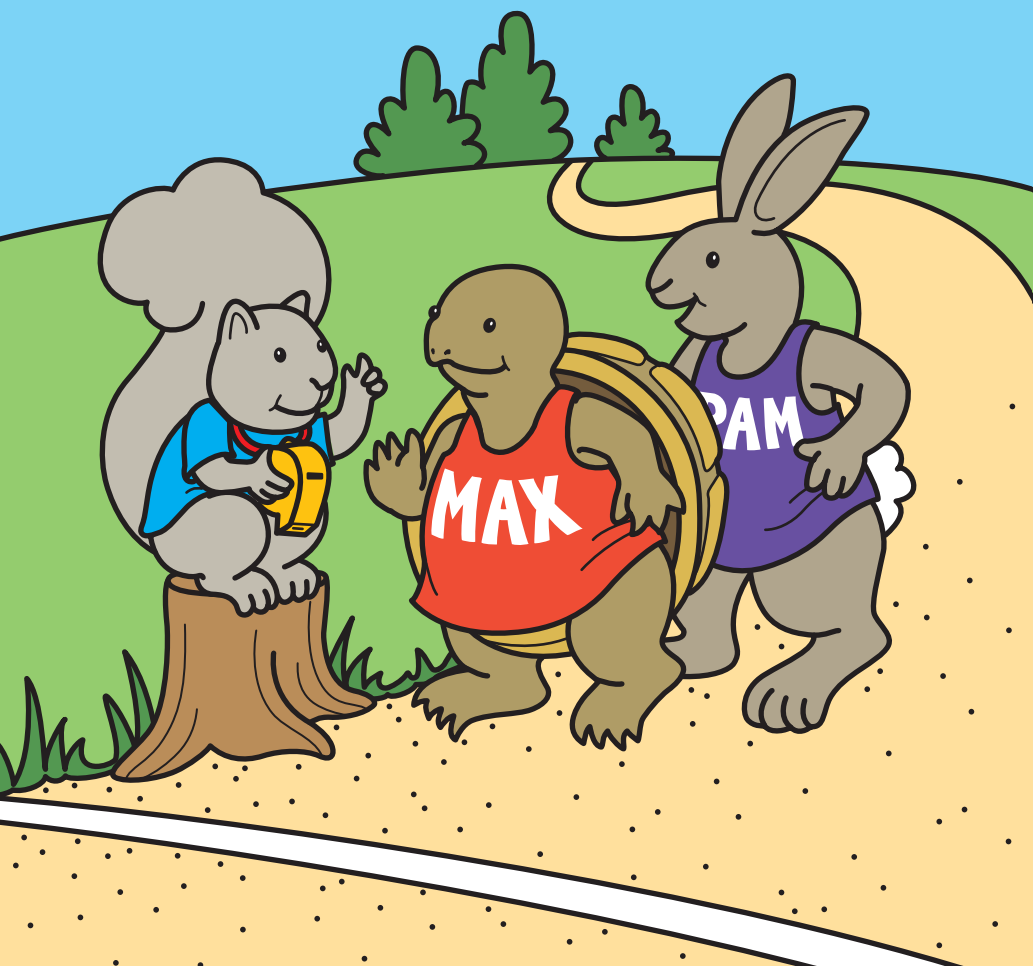
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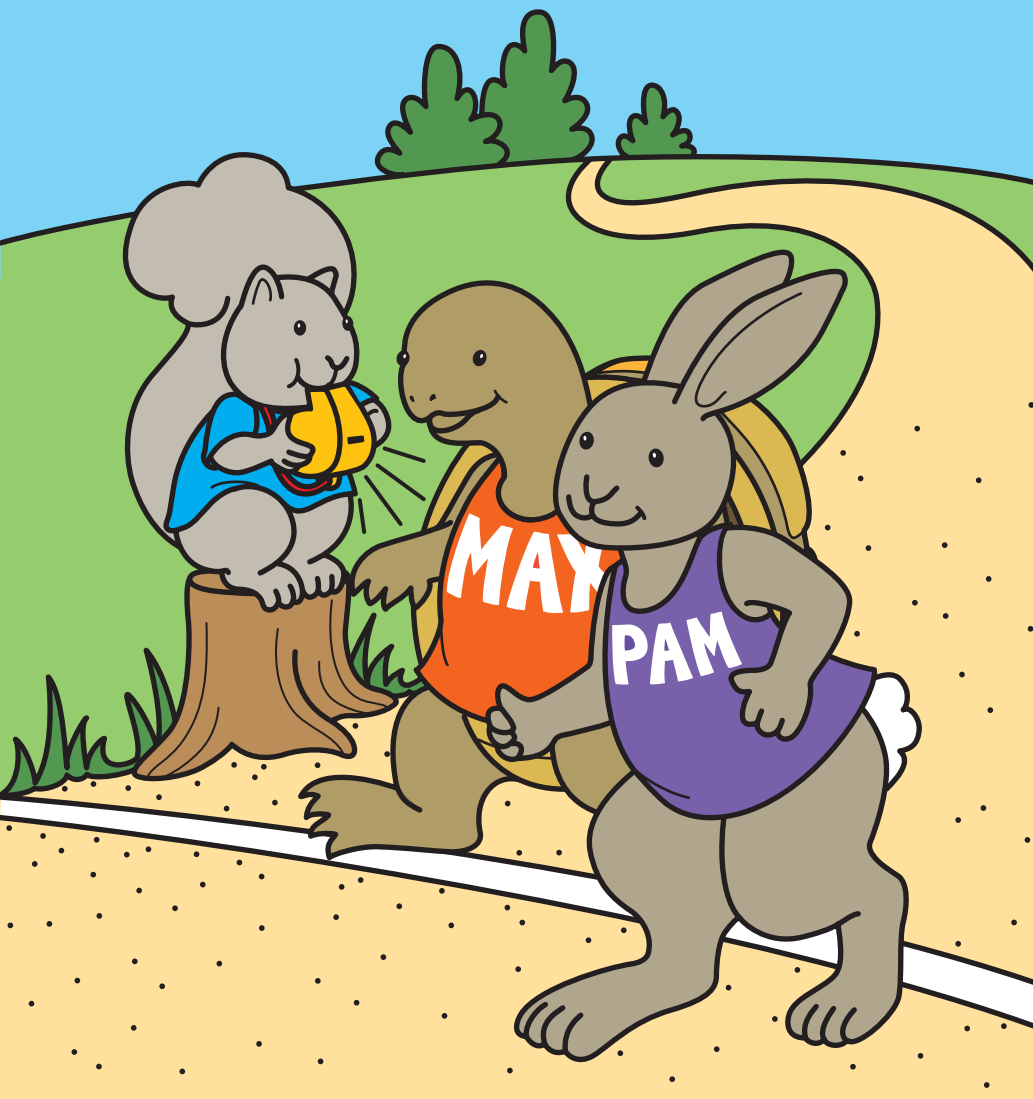
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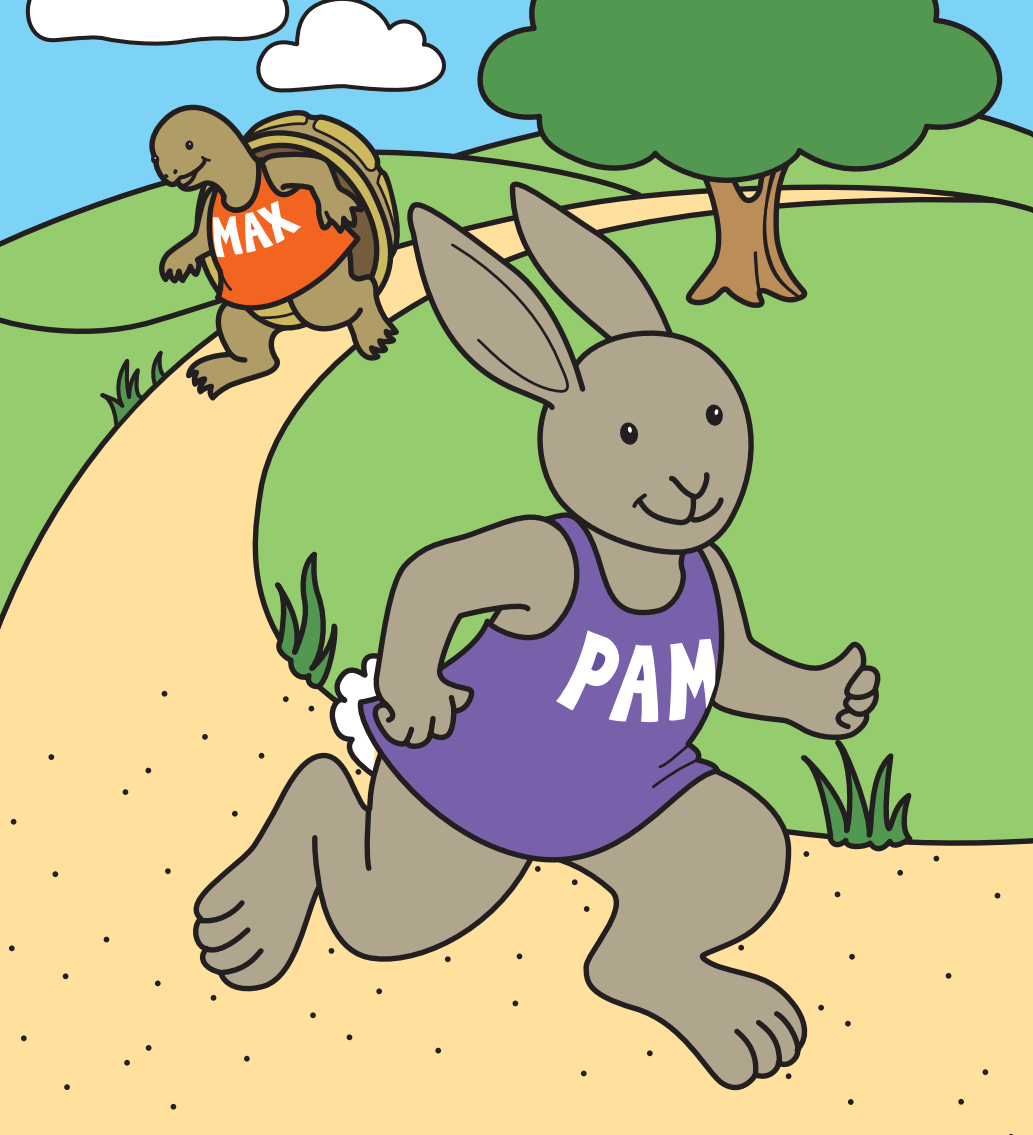
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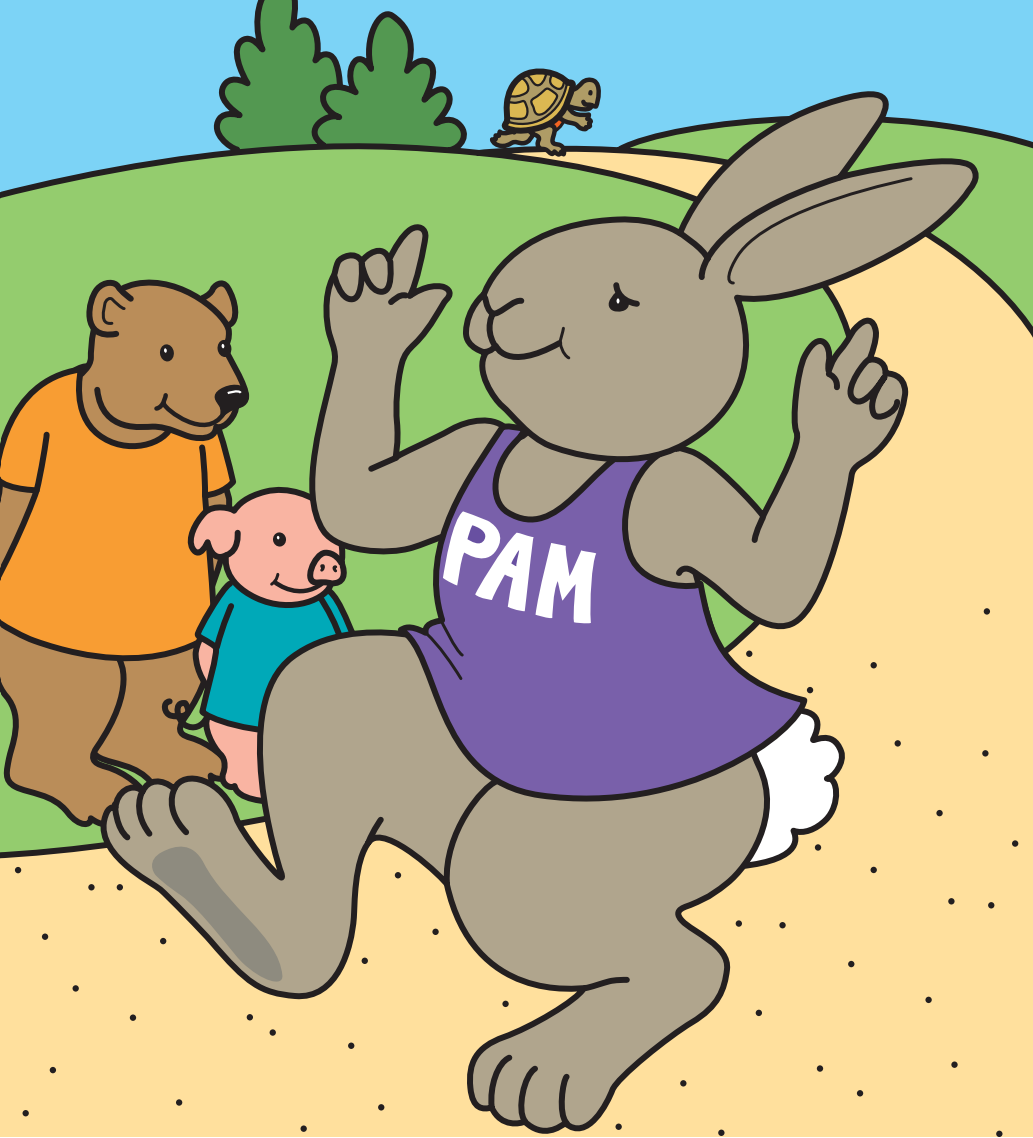
Look at Pam.

🔊 One, two, go, go, go!



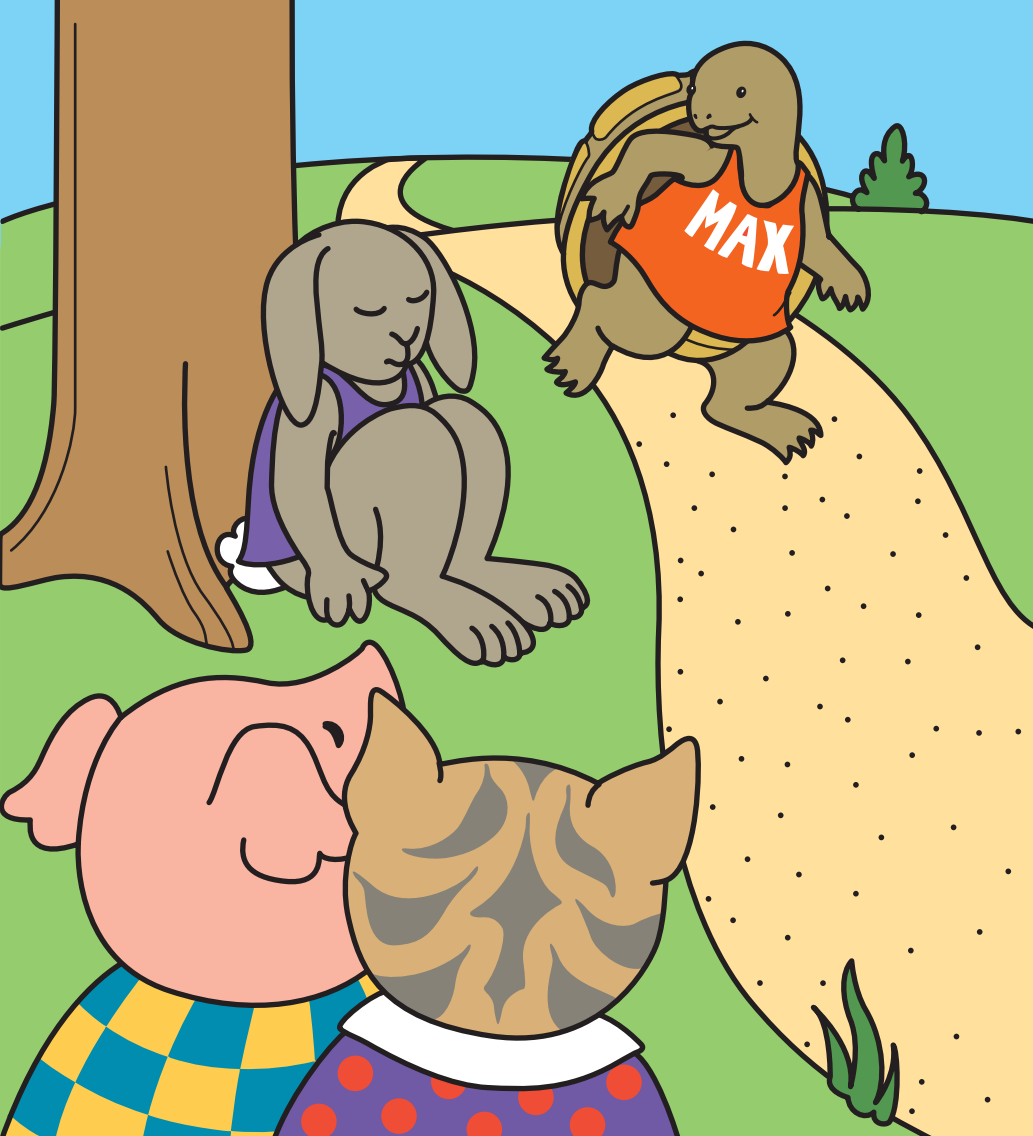
▶ Pam will go.
