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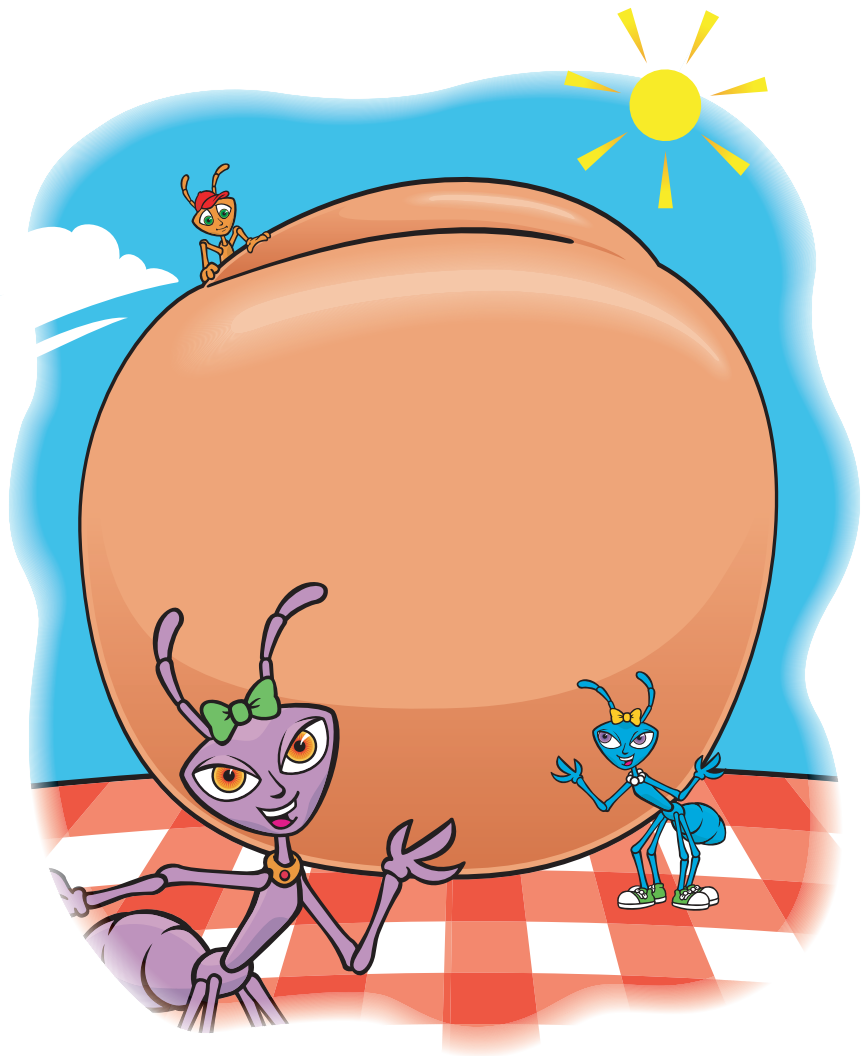
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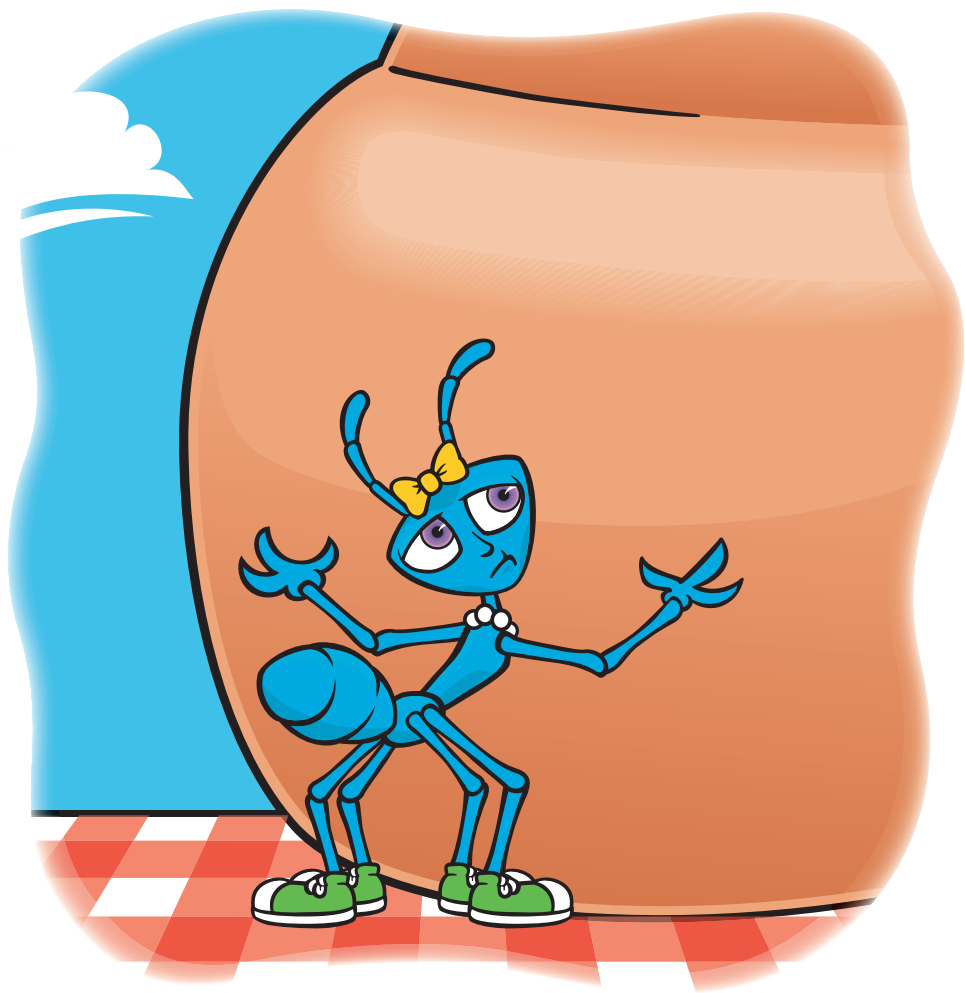
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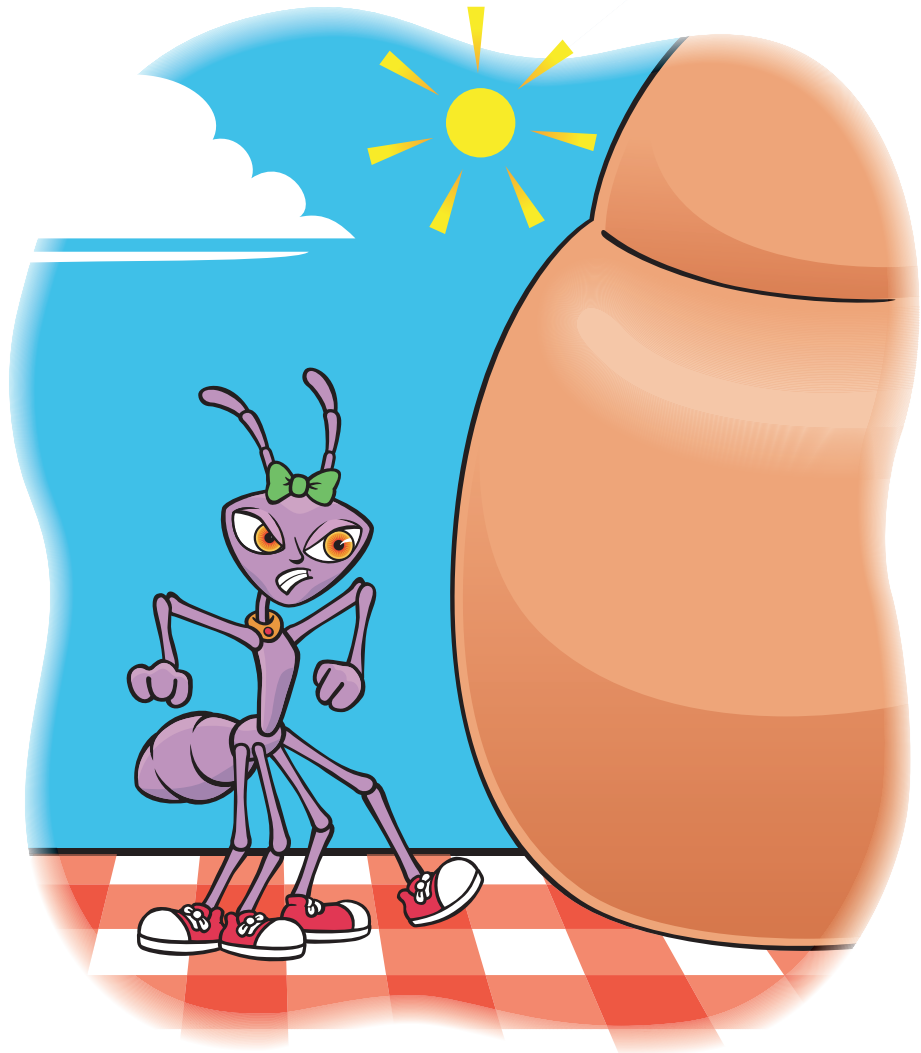
Look at this.

We want to get it.



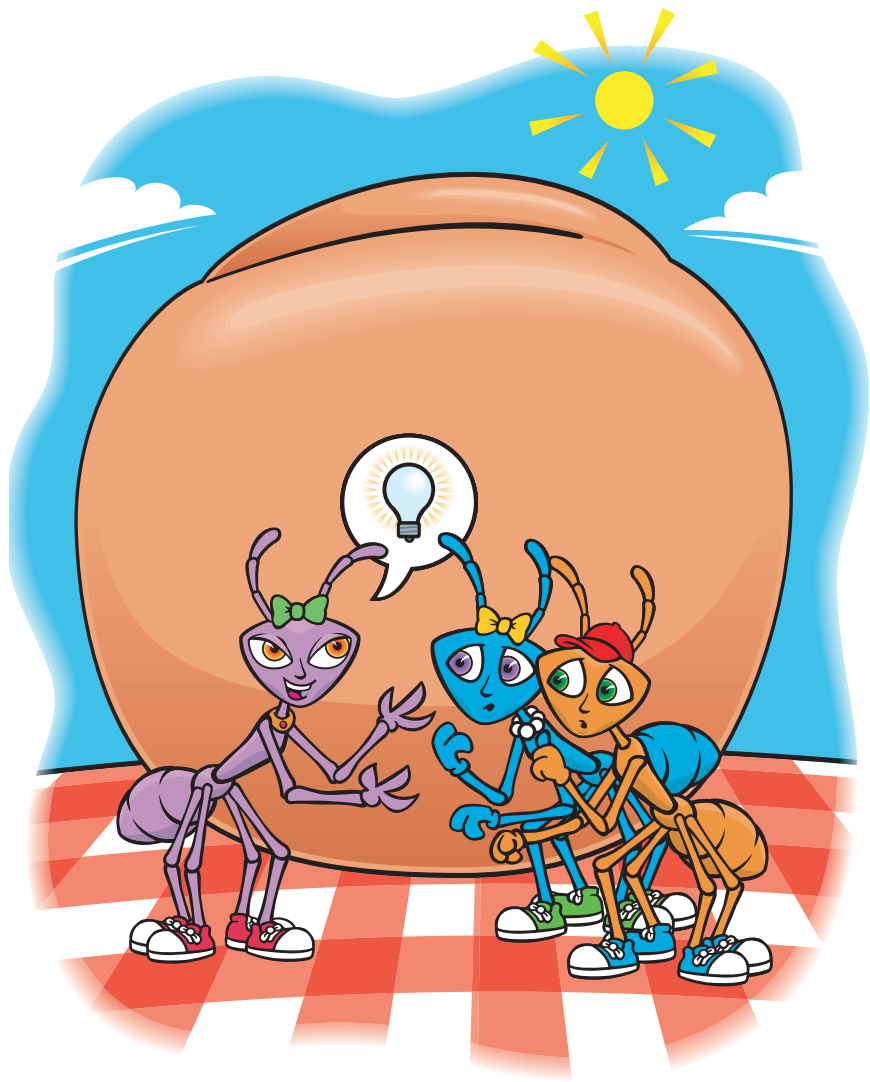
Val can not get the bun.

She is little.



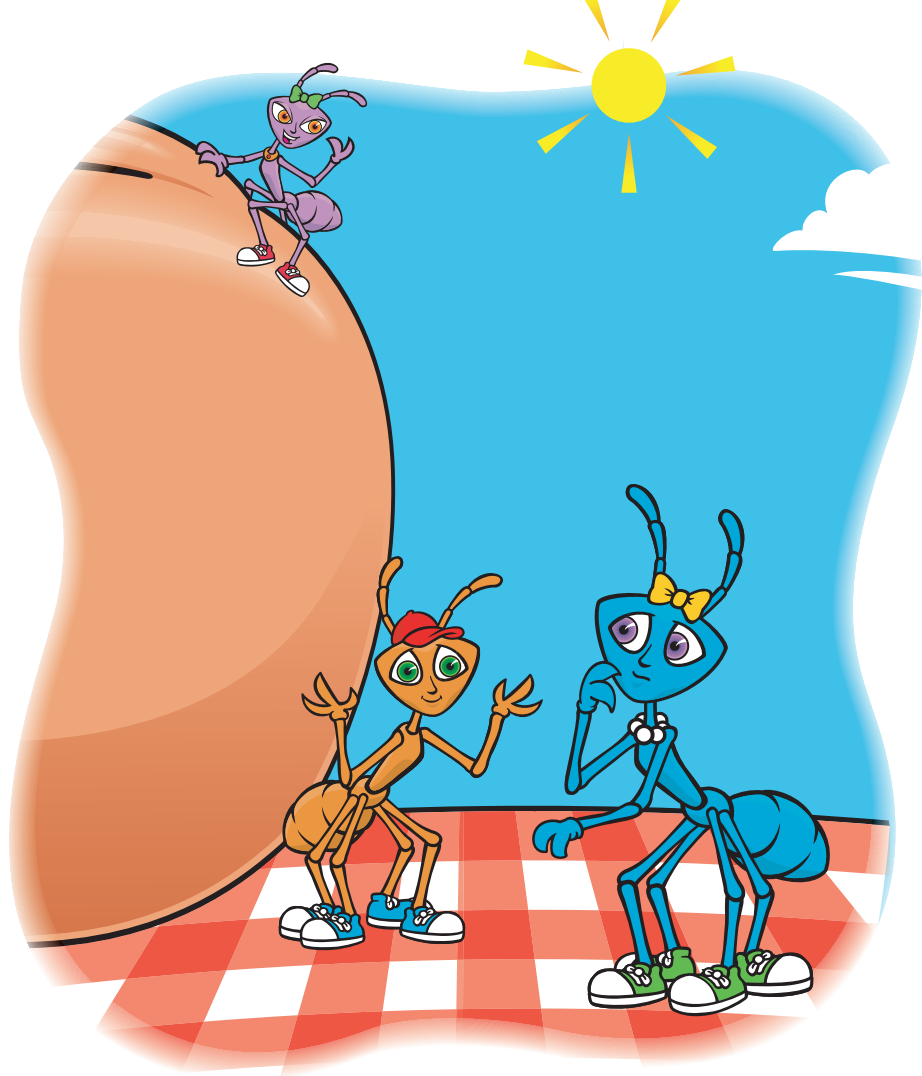
Bill can not get the bun.

He is little.



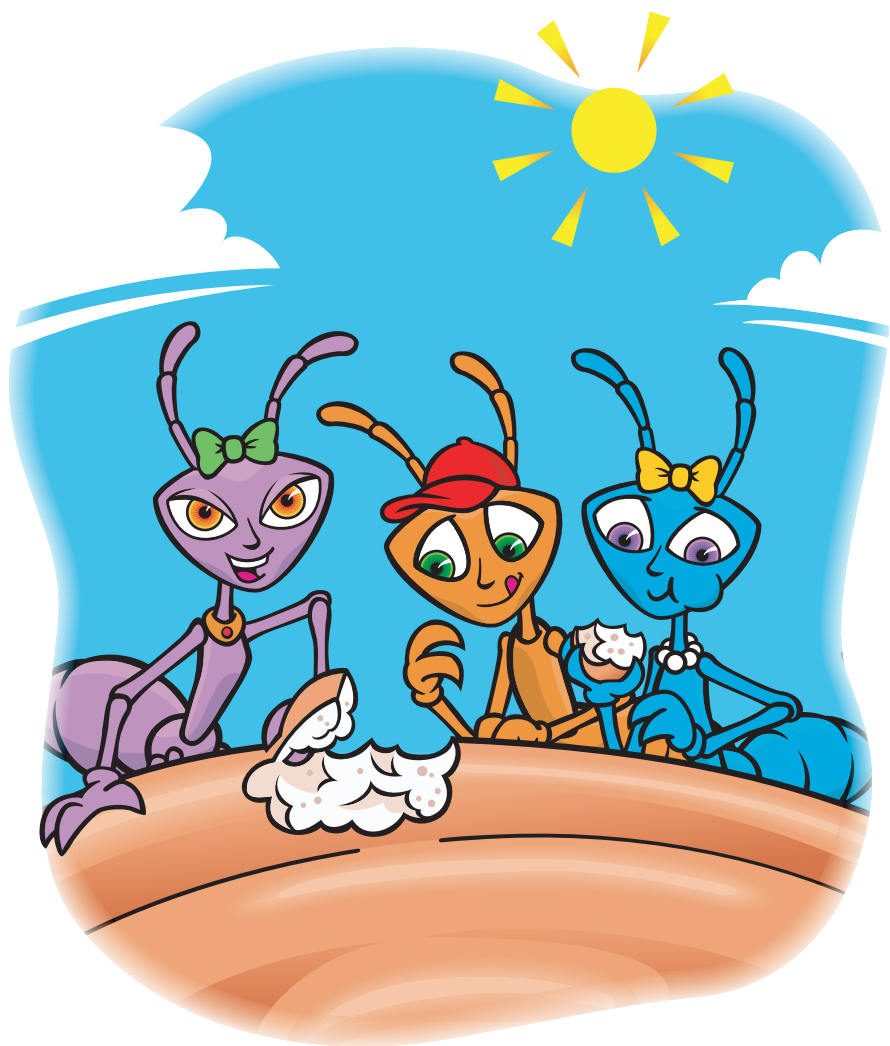
■ Lil can not get the bun.
