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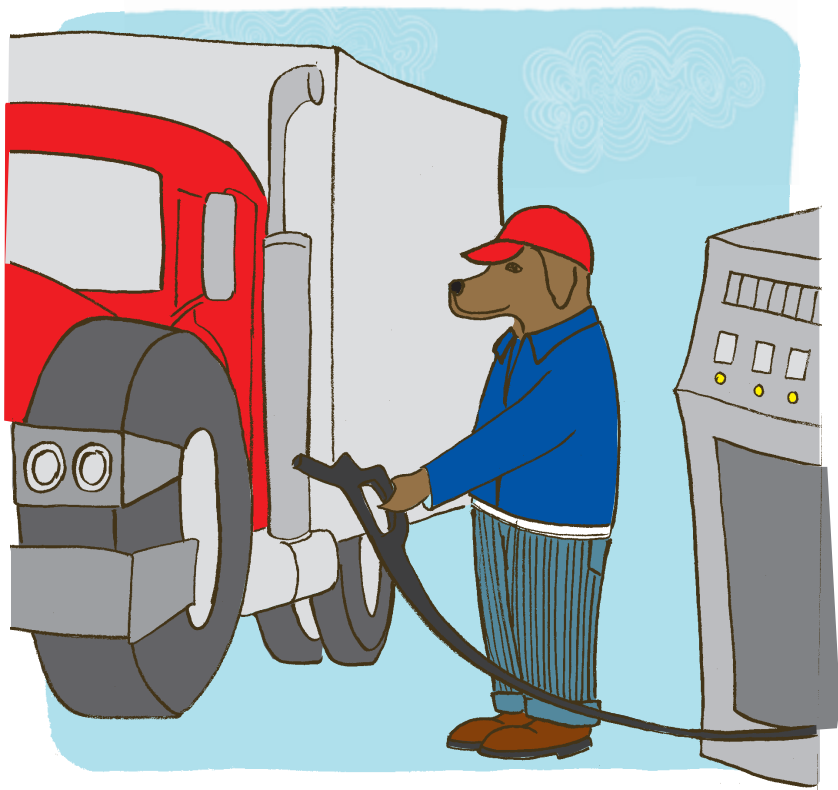
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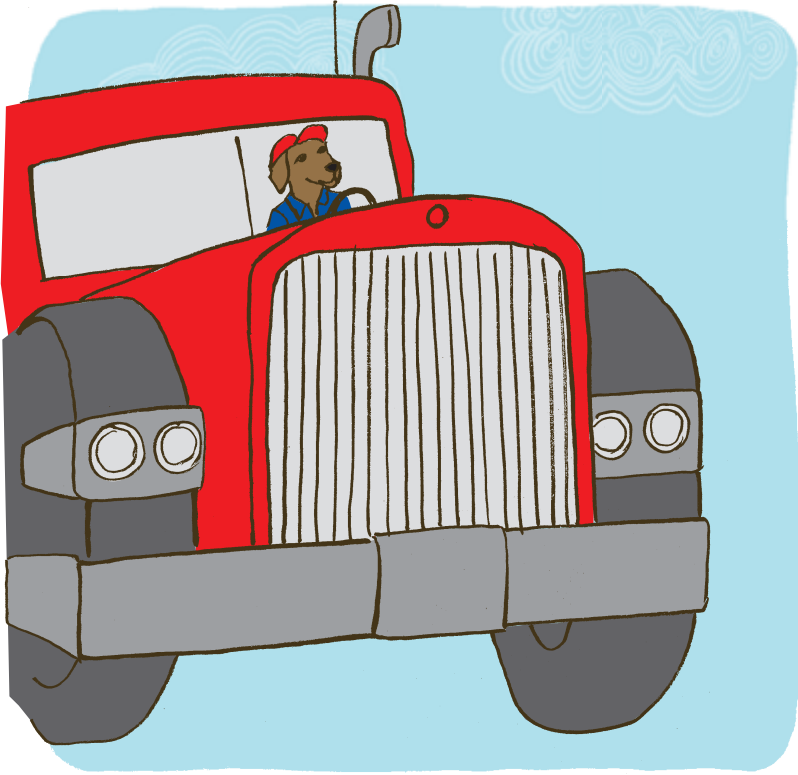
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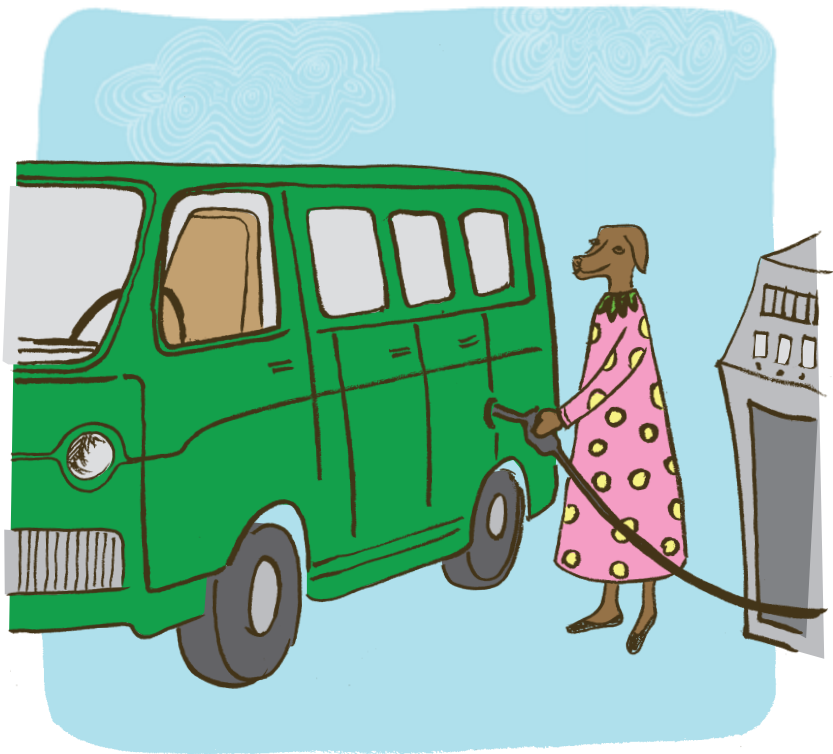
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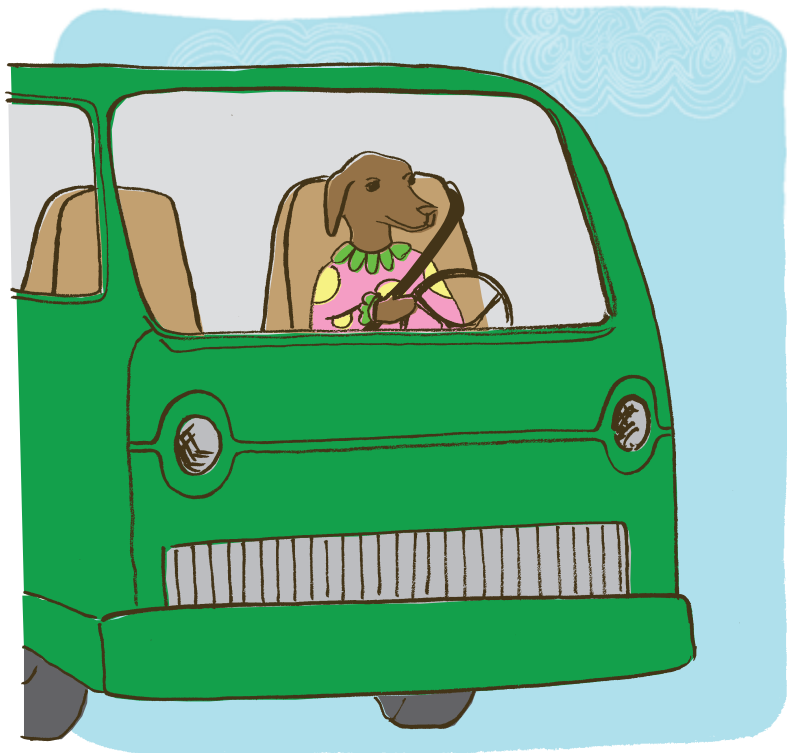
■ Dad has to go.

It will go in the van.



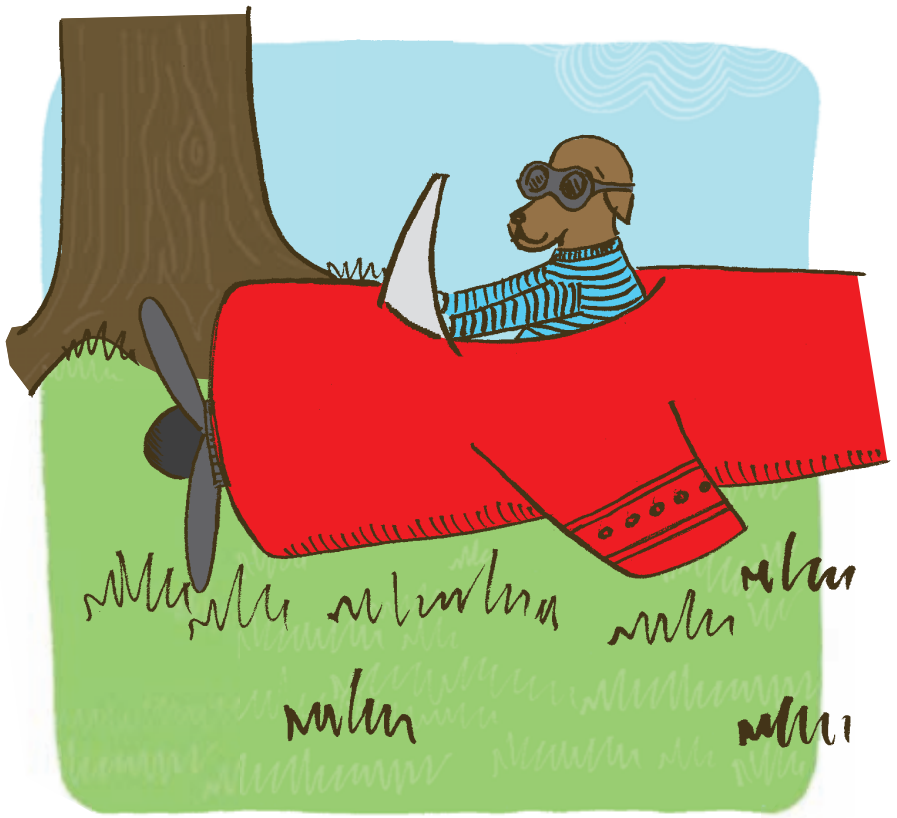
Look at Mom go.
