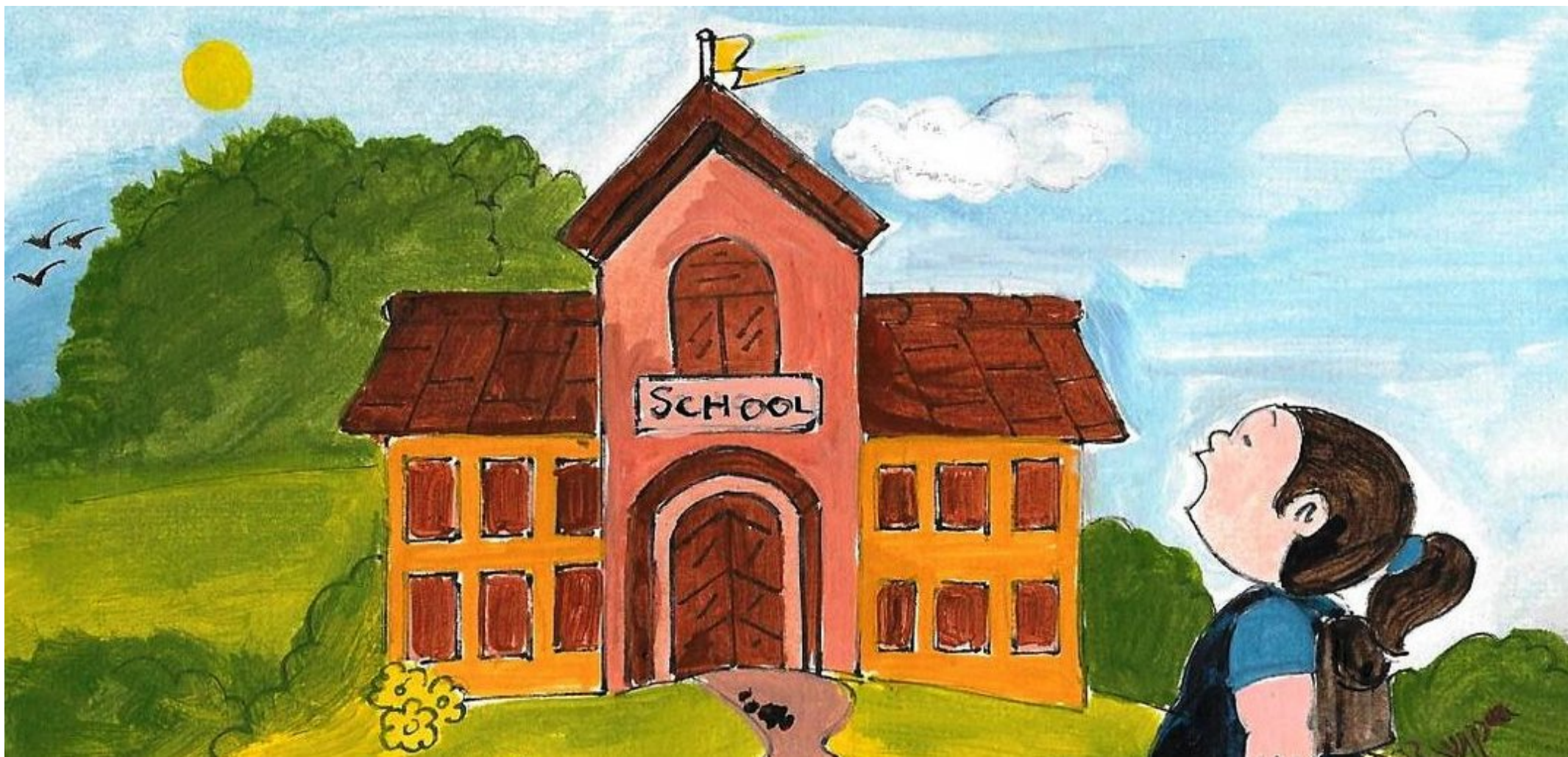




my first day in my new school

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Level 2



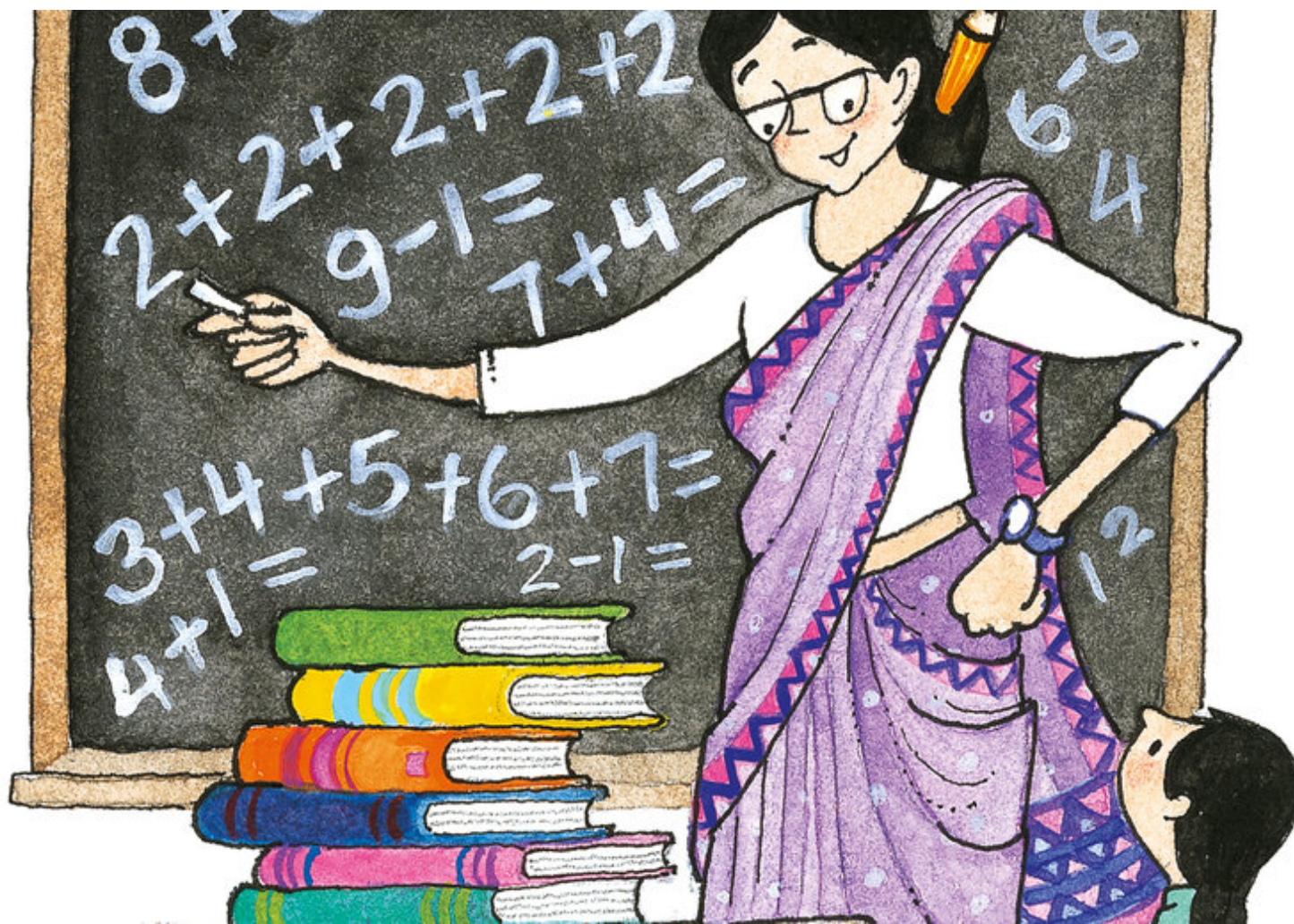
The day I reached school I was excited to see the wonderful school my parents had sent me to. The school was painted in bright colors of the world.



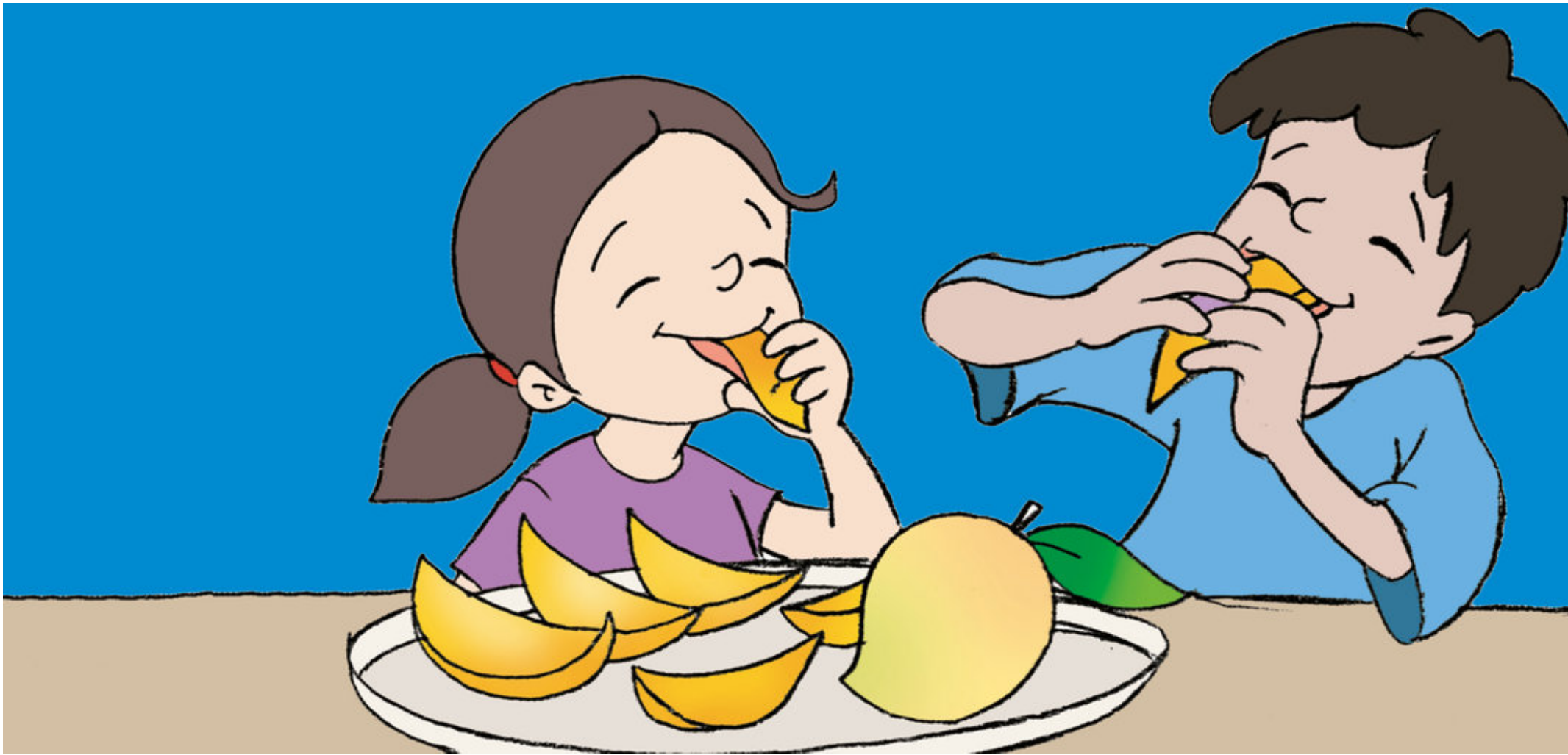
