that stood by the lake.

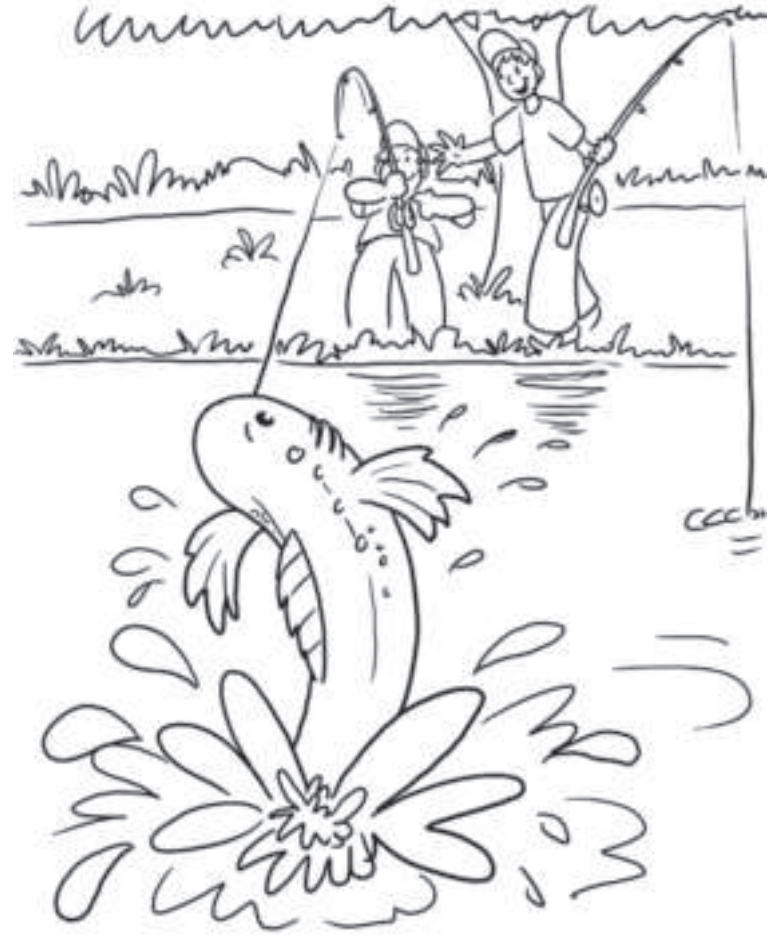


Kevin and Max checked
