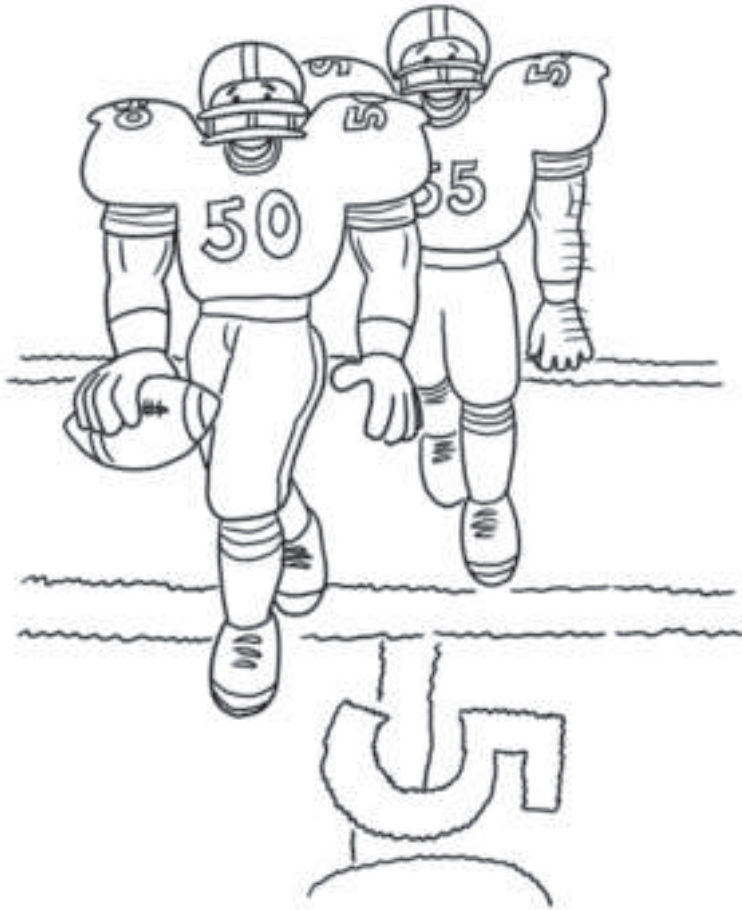


My sister is taking me
