

LISTENING SCRIPTS – SEMESTER 2 TEST

Narrator: Look at Part 1.

Listen and put a tick or a cross in the box.

There are two examples.

Example A.

B: Hey, Daisy. I have a ball.

G: A ball? Wow!

Narrator: Example B.

G: Hi, Peter. I have a teddy bear.

B: A teddy bear?

Narrator: Can you see the answers?

Now you listen and put a tick or a cross in the box.

One.

G: Hmmm. I want a sandwich.

B: A sandwich? OK.

Narrator: Two.

G: Look, Peter. I have a teddy bear.

B: Really? A teddy bear?

Narrator: Three.

B: Lily, I can sing!

G: You can sing? OK.

Narrator: Now, listen to Part 1 again.

(Repeat)

That is the end of Part 1.

Narrator: Part 2.

Listen and tick the box.

There is one example.

G: Look. This is my bedroom.

W: Oh. Your bedroom?

Narrator: Can you see the tick?

Now you listen and tick the box.

Four.

B: Hmmm. I want a cookie.

G: You want a cookie? OK.

Narrator: Five.

G: Look, Paul. I can run.

B: Wow! You can run, Vicky!

Narrator: Six.

G: This is my living room, Jack.

B: Your living room? I like it.

Narrator: Now, listen to Part 2 again.

(Repeat)

That is the end of Part 2.

Narrator: Part 3.

Listen and tick the box.

There is one example.

B: Hey, Julia. I can sing.

G: You can? OK, then. Sing!

Narrator: Can you see the tick? Now you listen and tick the box.

Seven.

G: Look, Jack! I can swim!

B: Wow, Lisa. You can swim!

Narrator: Eight.

B: Hmmm. I want a banana.

G: A banana? Mmm. Good idea!

Narrator: Nine.

G: I have a car, Peter.

B: A car? Wow, Vicky!

Narrator: Now, listen to Part 3 again.

(Repeat)

That is the end of Part 3.

Narrator: Part 4.

Listen and write a number.

There is one example.

G: How many books?

B: Seven books.

Narrator: Can you see the answer? Now you listen and write a number
Ten.

B: How many cars?

G: Nine cars.

Narrator: Eleven.

G: How old are you?

B: I'm eight.

Narrator: Twelve.

B: How many balls?

G: Five balls.

Narrator: Now, listen to Part 4 again.

(Repeat)

That is the end of the Listening test.
