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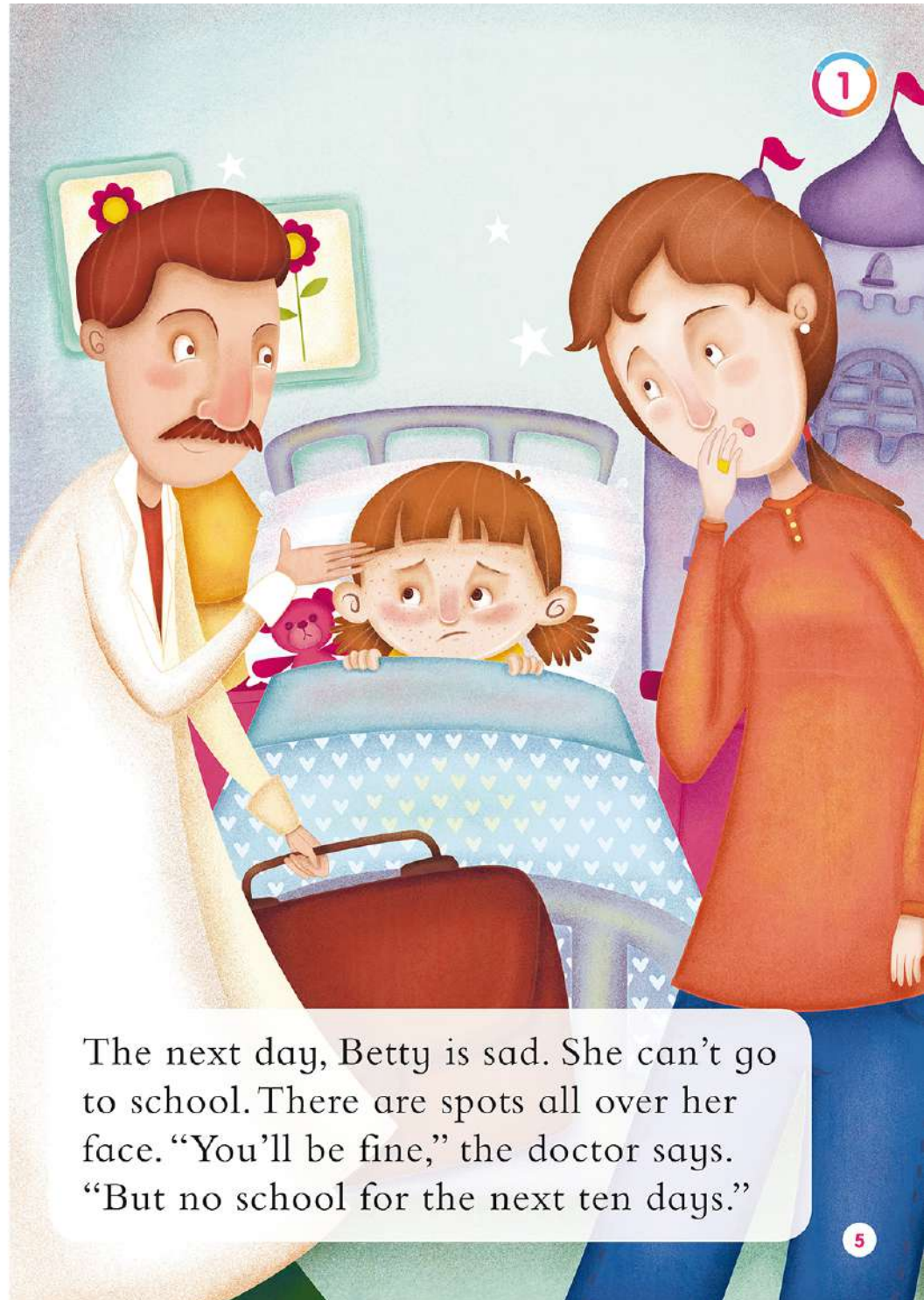
My Favorite Thing

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The next day, Betty is sad. She can't go to school. There are spots all over her face. “You'll be fine,” the doctor says. “But no school for the next ten days.”

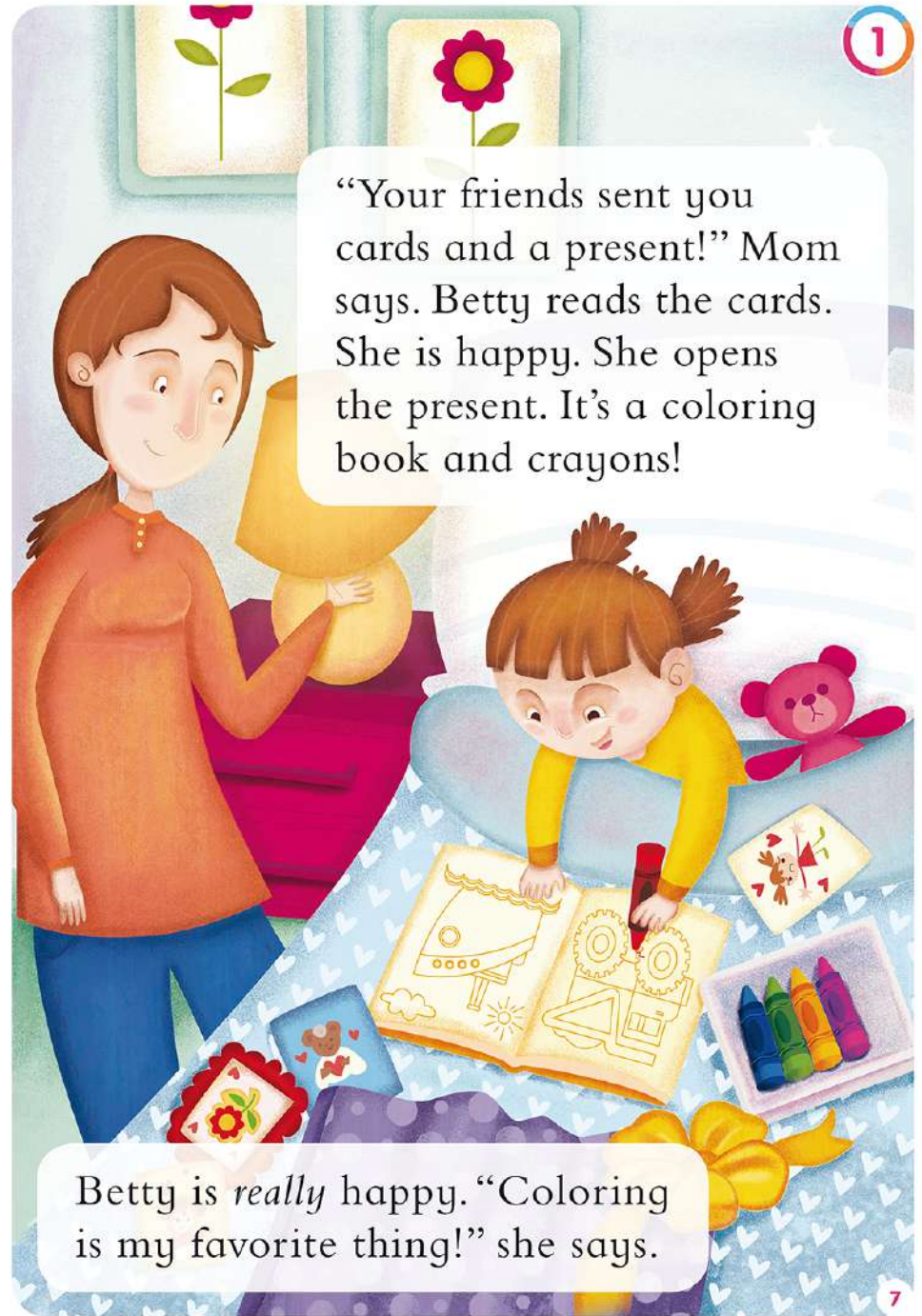

Good job, Oliver!



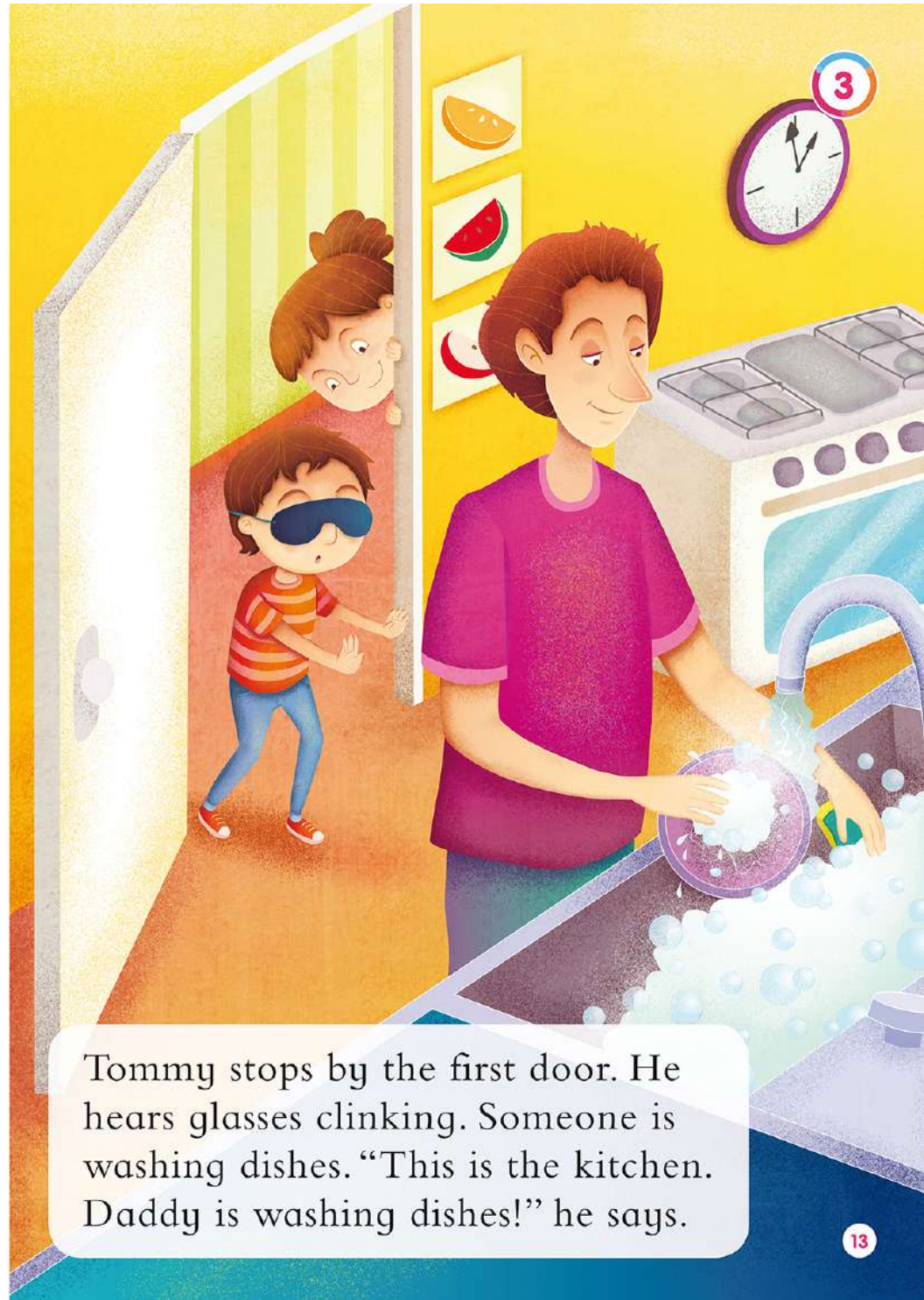
Oliver goes to the kitchen.

Good job, Oliver!



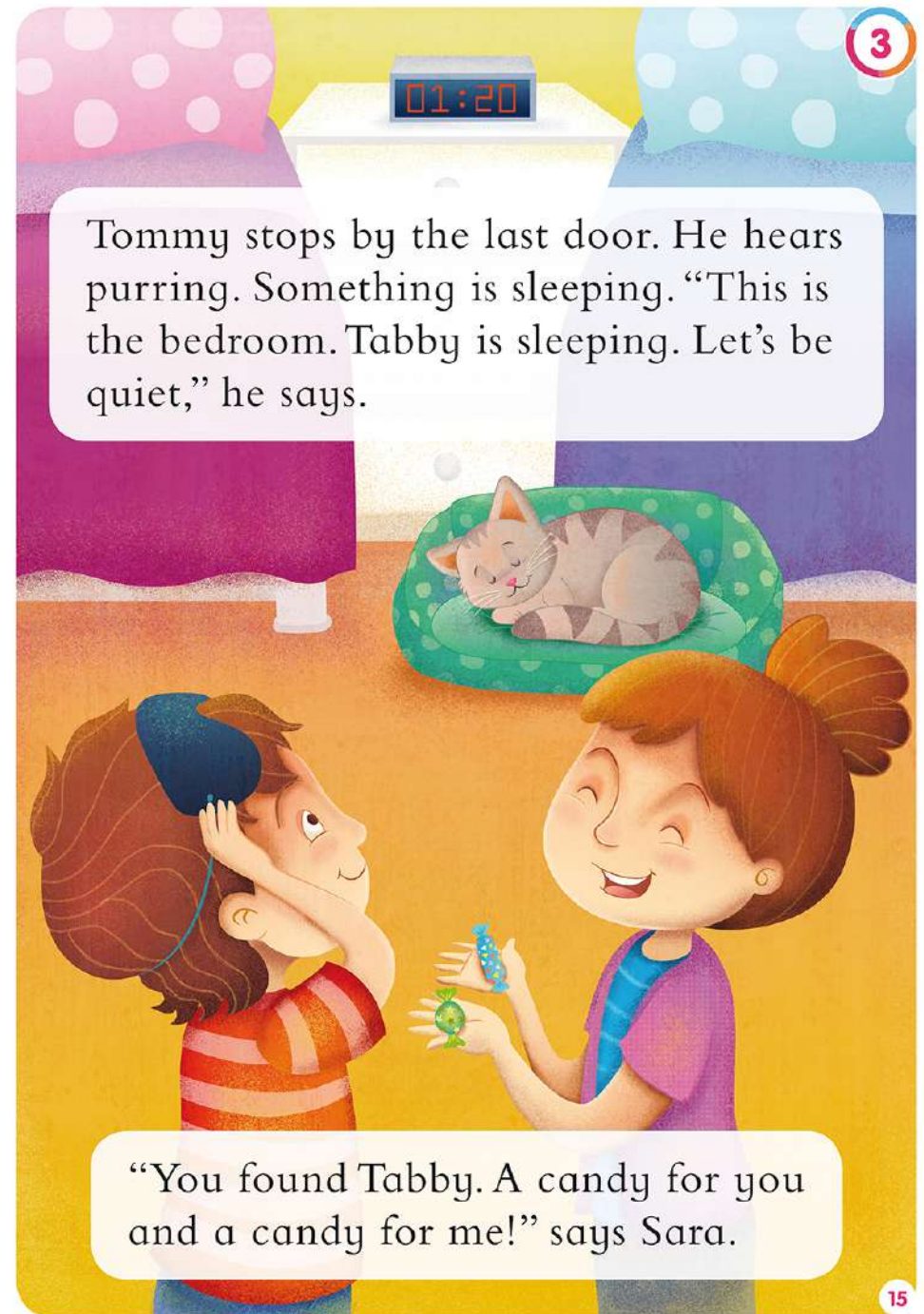
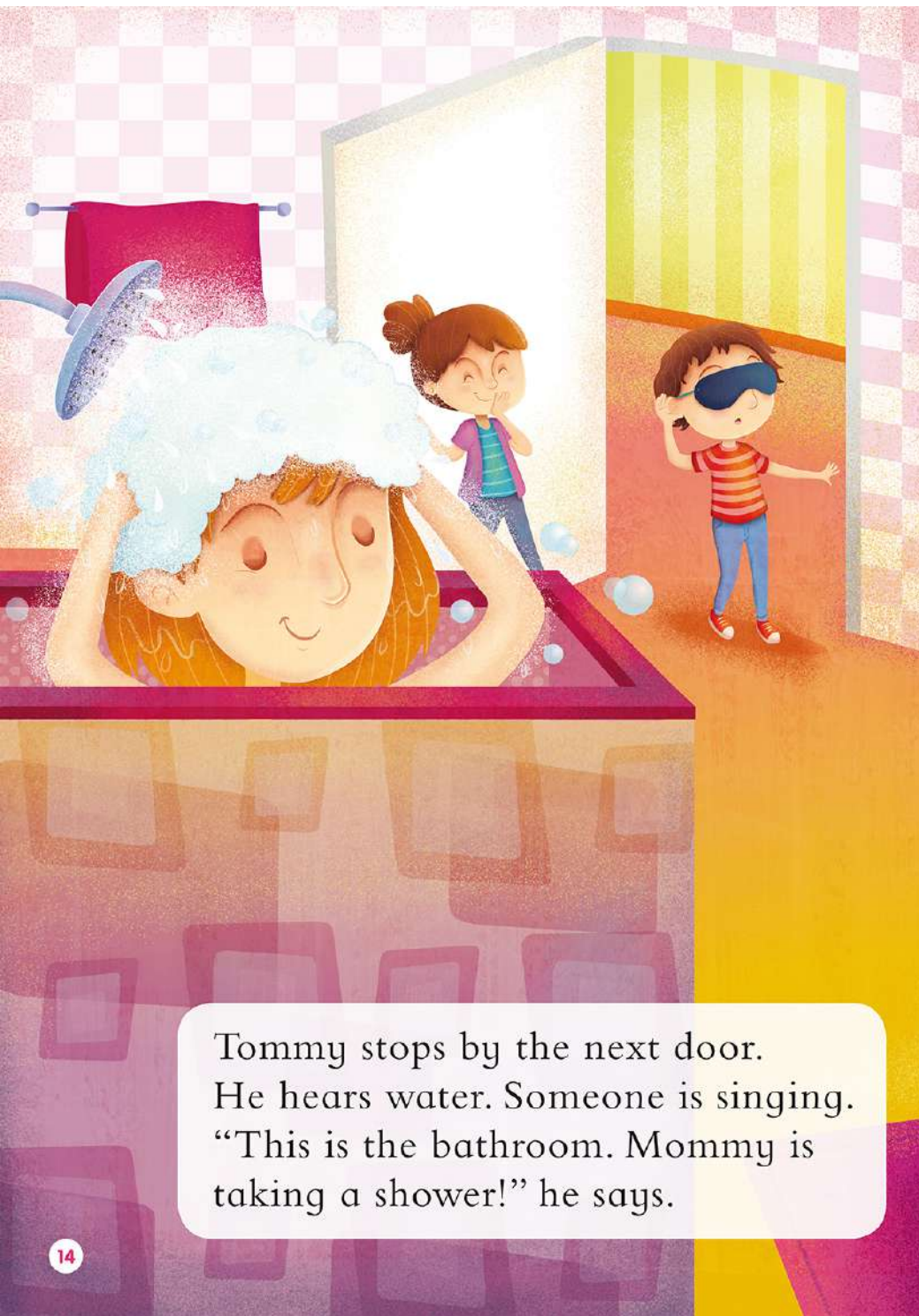
Oliver looks out the window.

A Fun Game

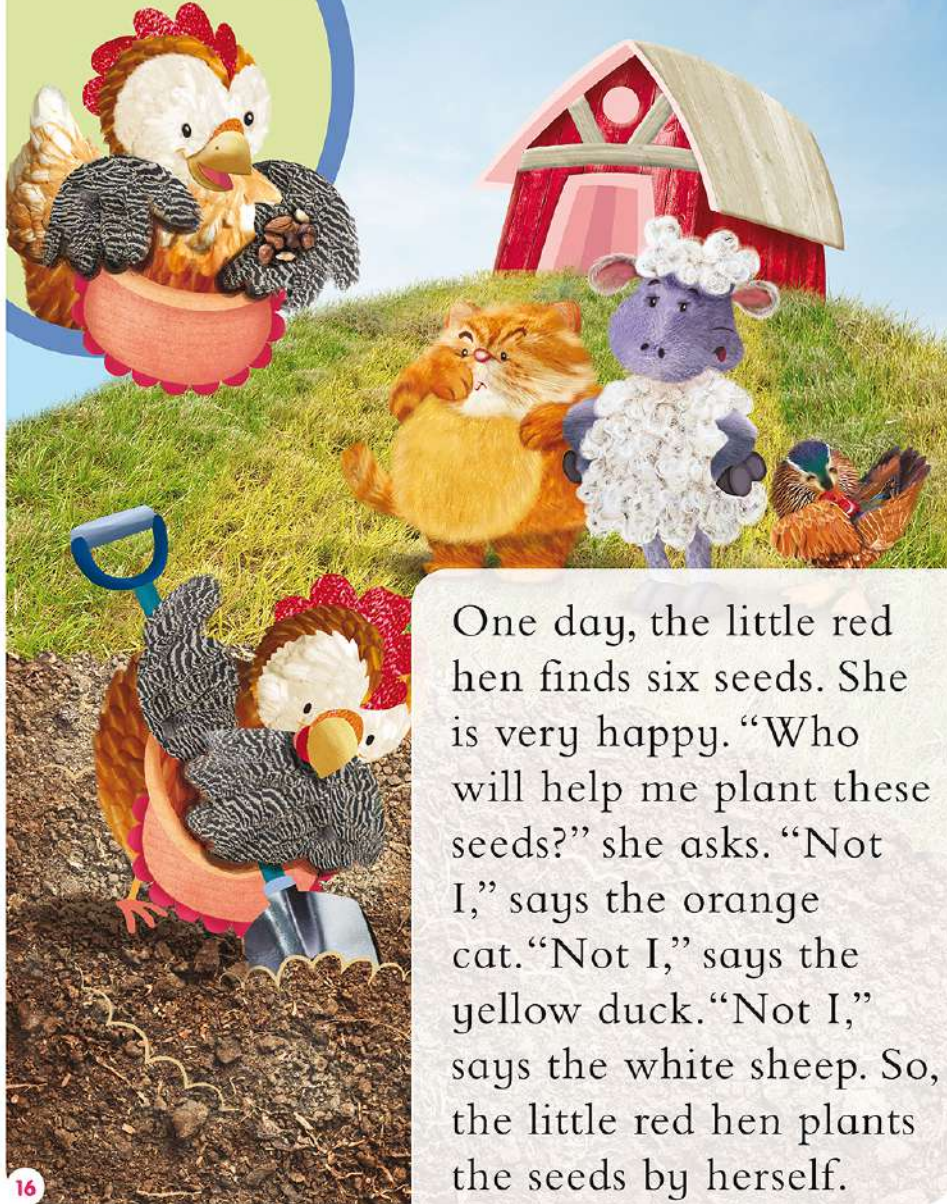
“Let’s play Find Tabby!” says Sara.

Daddy is washing dishes!” he says.

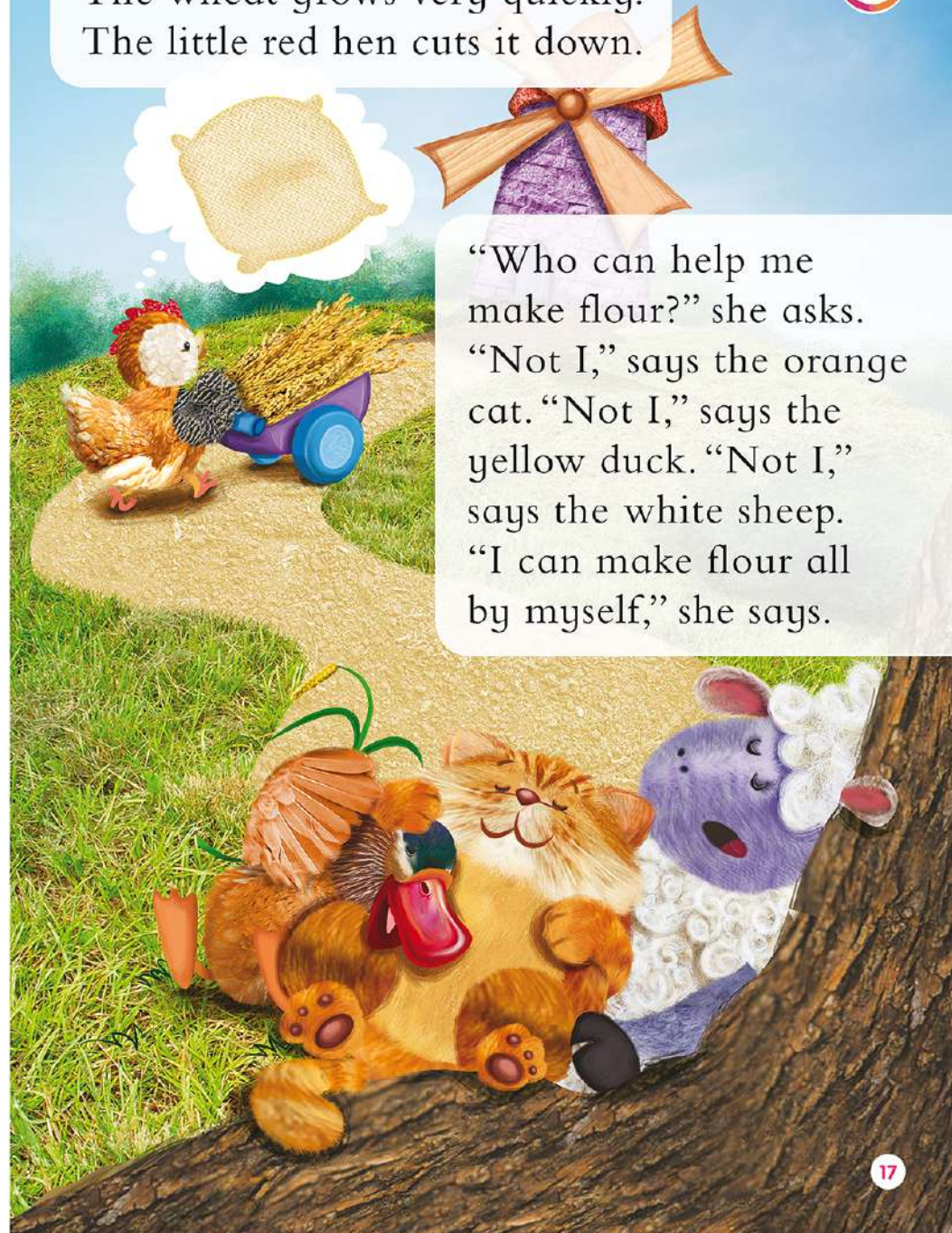


The Little Red Hen

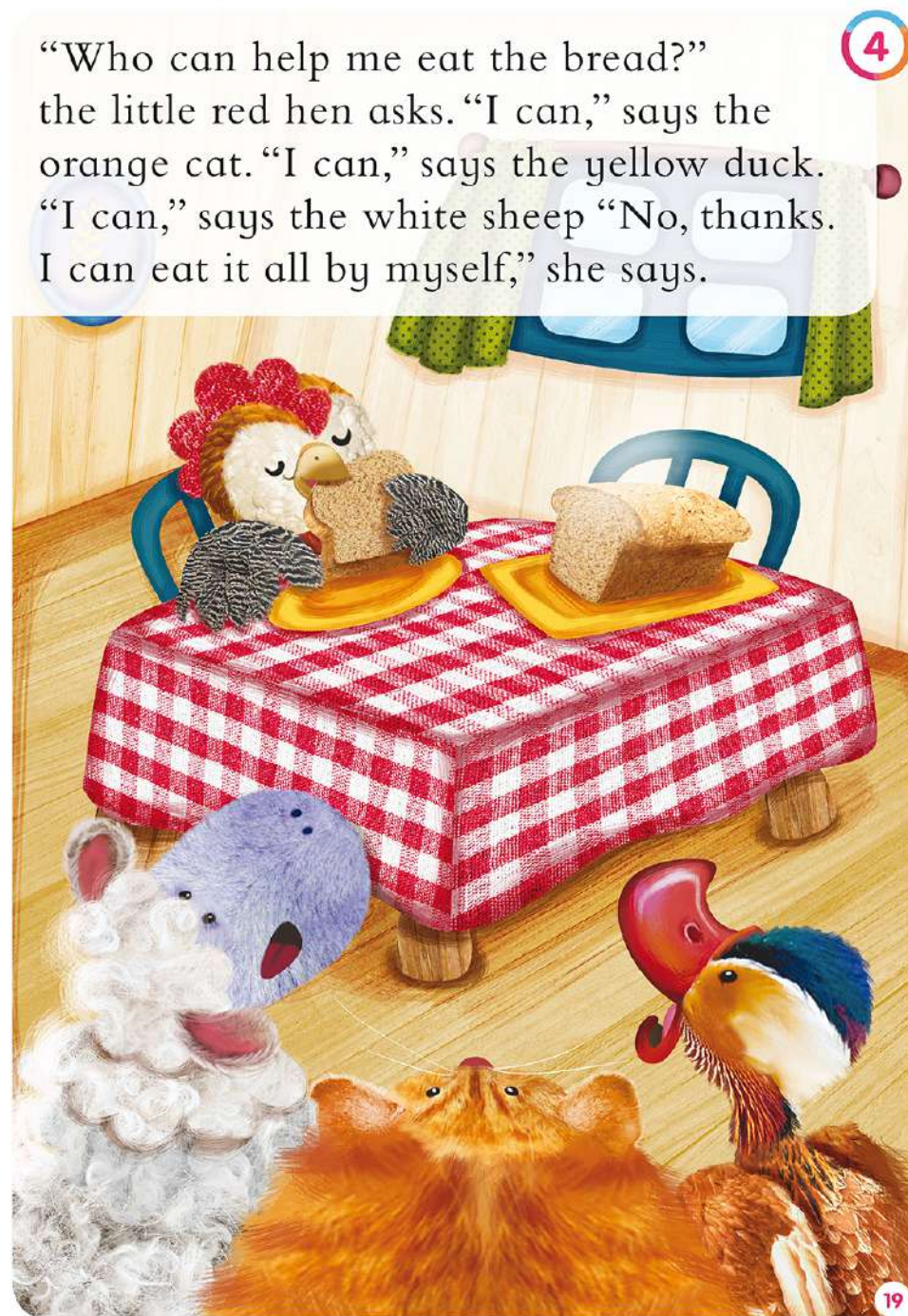


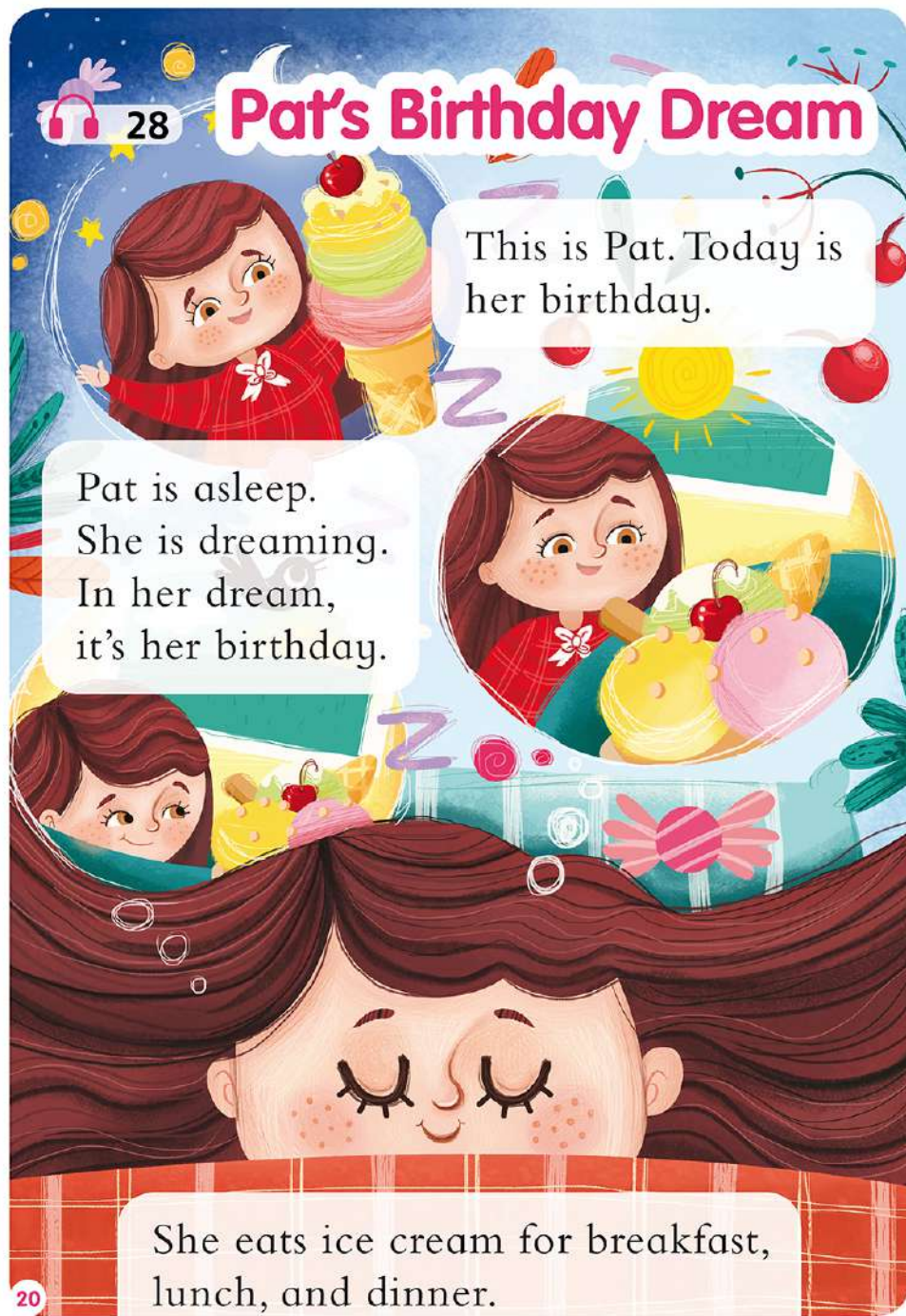

Boys and girls, welcome to the Teddy Bear Show! Let's begin.



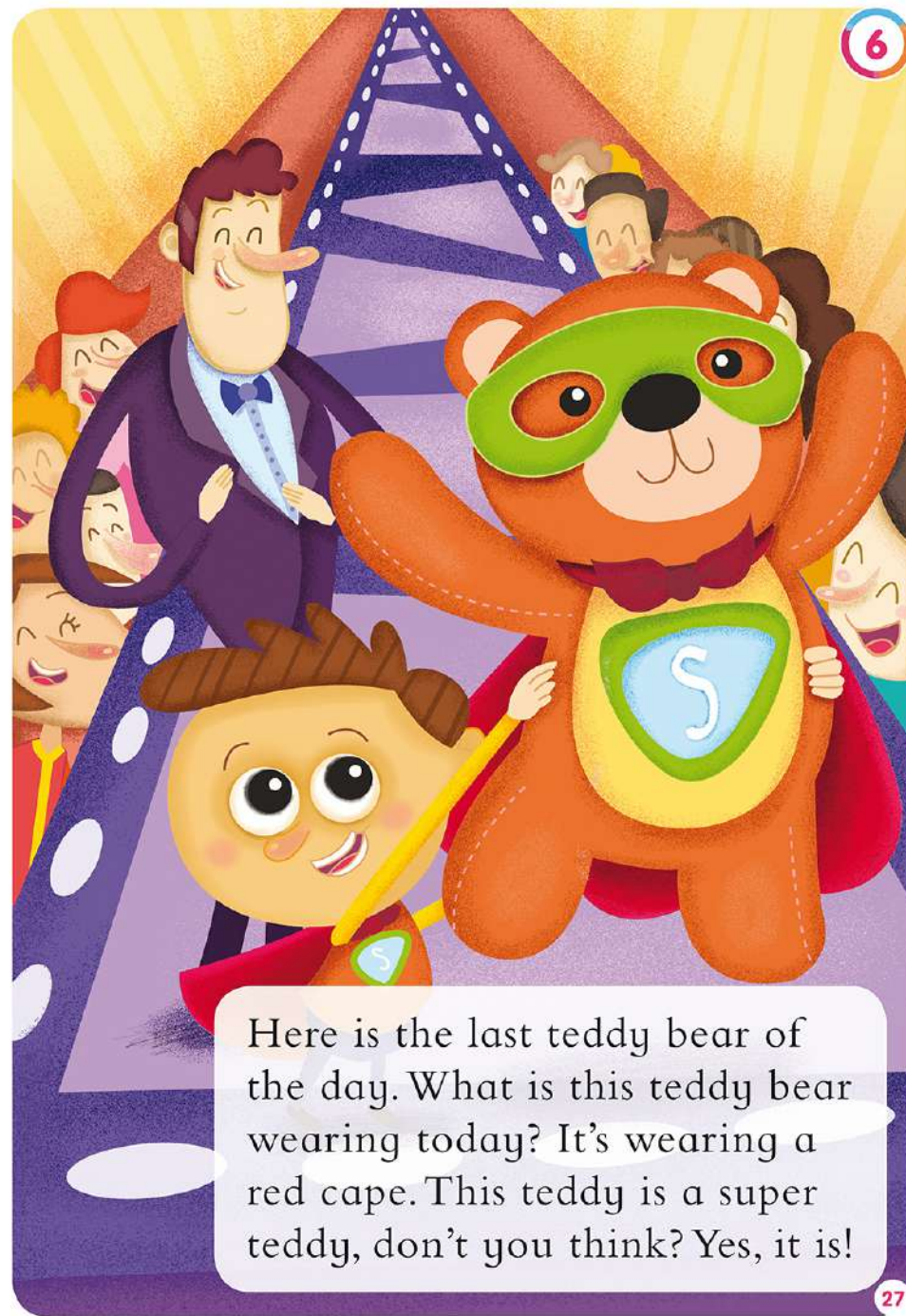
Look, what do we have here? What is this small teddy bear wearing today? It's wearing a green scarf and a wig. This teddy is very cute, don't you think? Yes, it is!

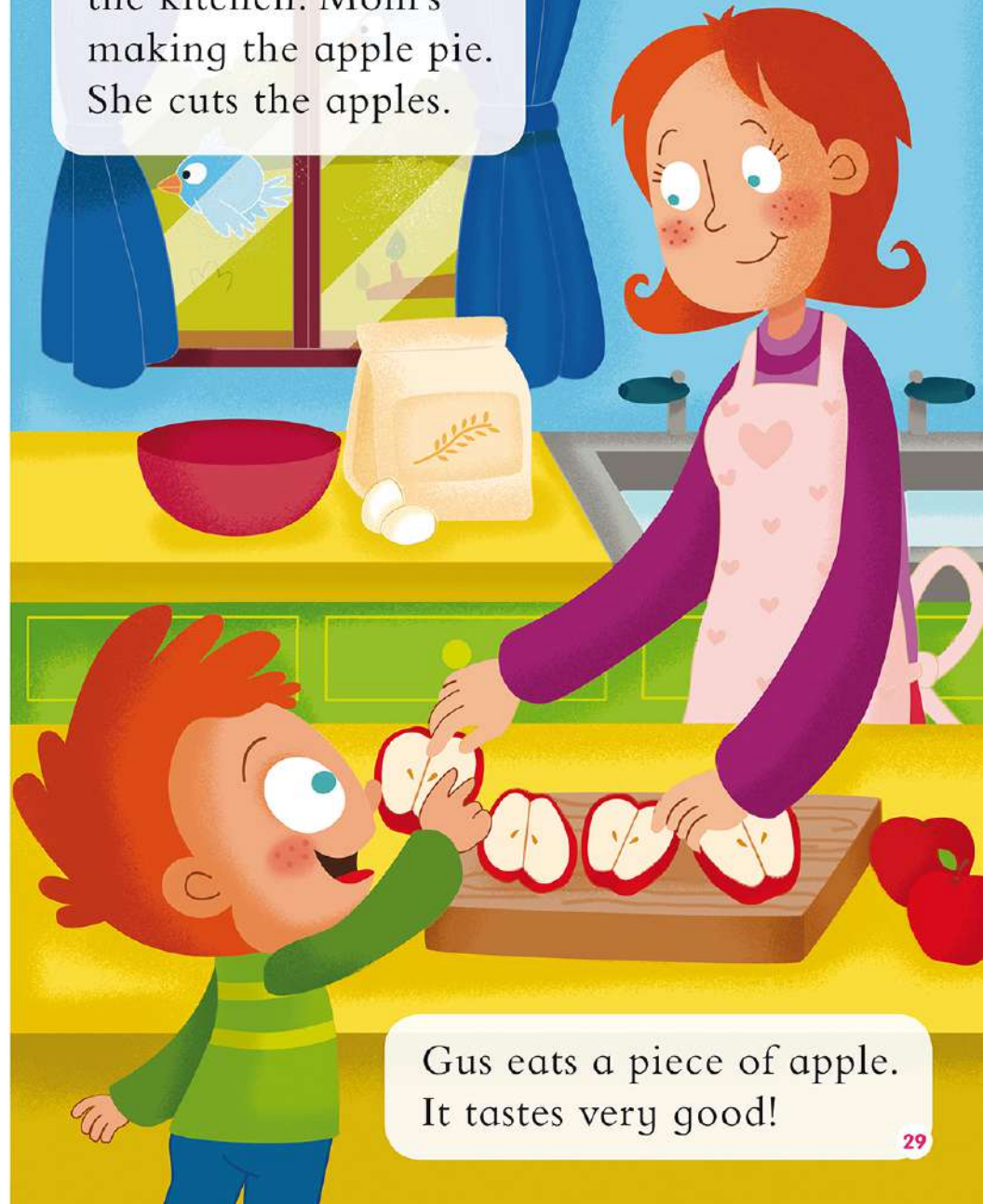
The Apple Pie

The sky is blue, and the sun is shining. Gus and his mom are at the fruit and vegetable stand. They see some red apples.

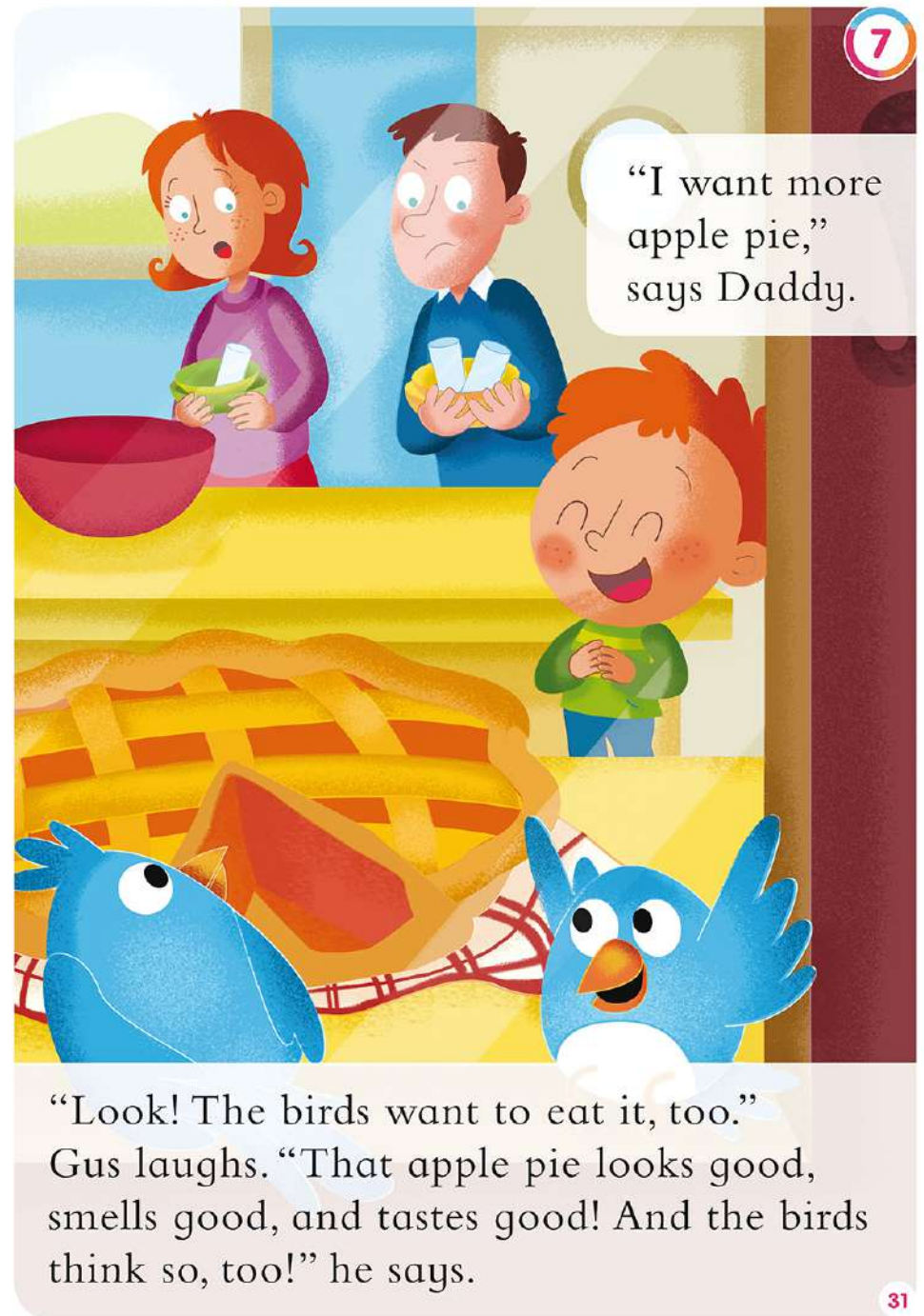


“Let’s make an apple pie!” says Mom. Gus loves apple pie.

Mom and Gus are in the kitchen. Mom’s making the apple pie. She cuts the apples.

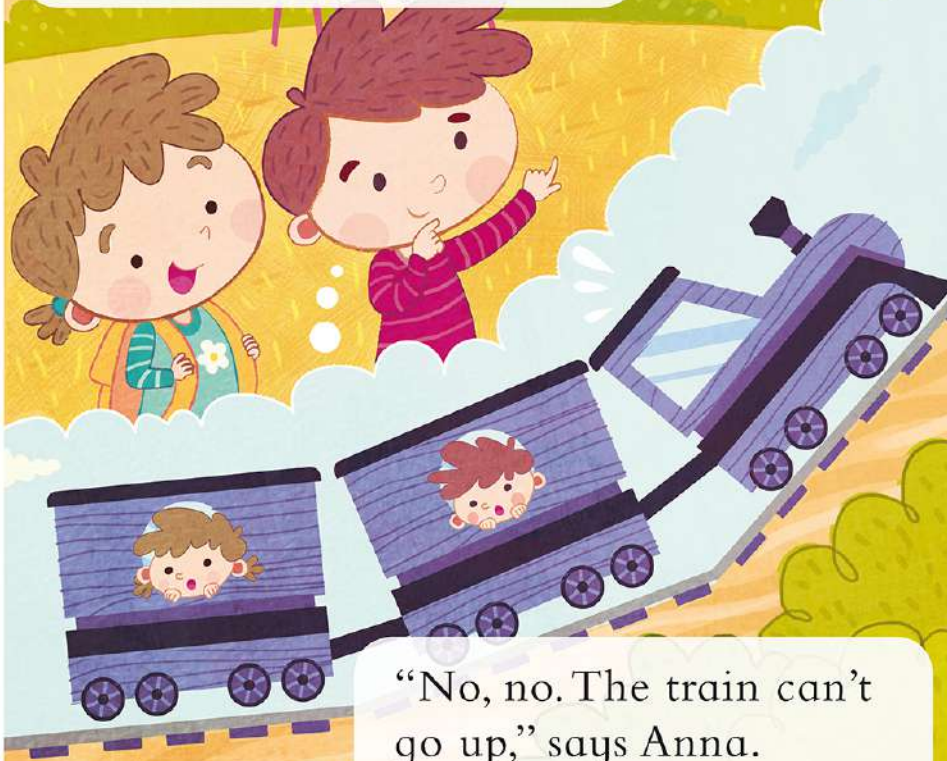


Gus eats a piece of apple. It tastes very good!



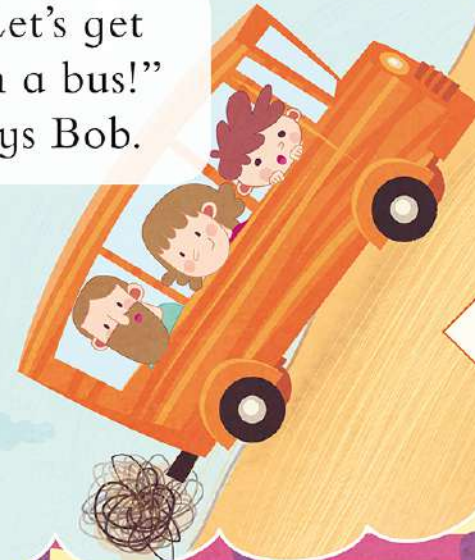
Let's Climb a Mountain!

bell. One, two, three ...

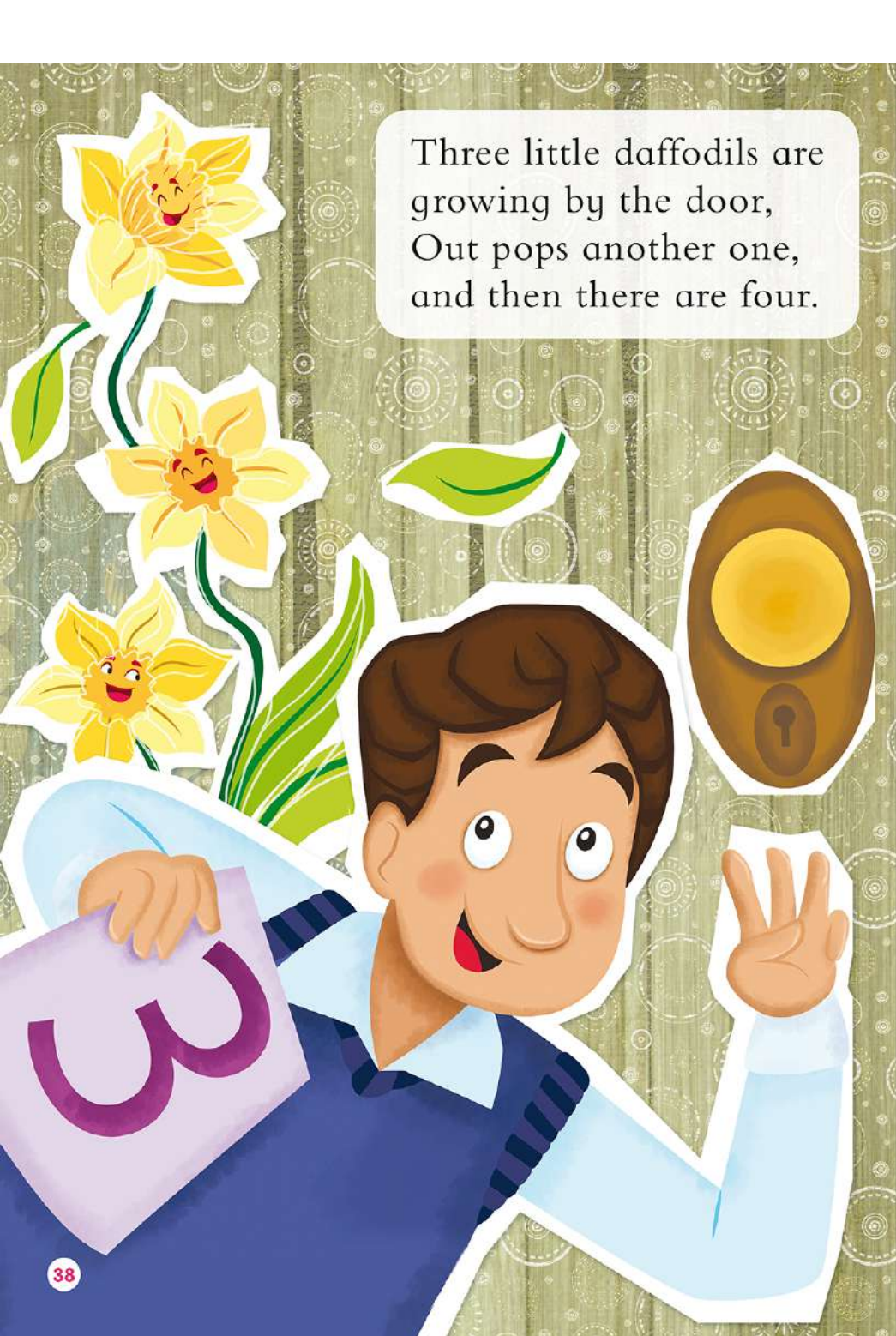
One little daffodil has

then there are two.

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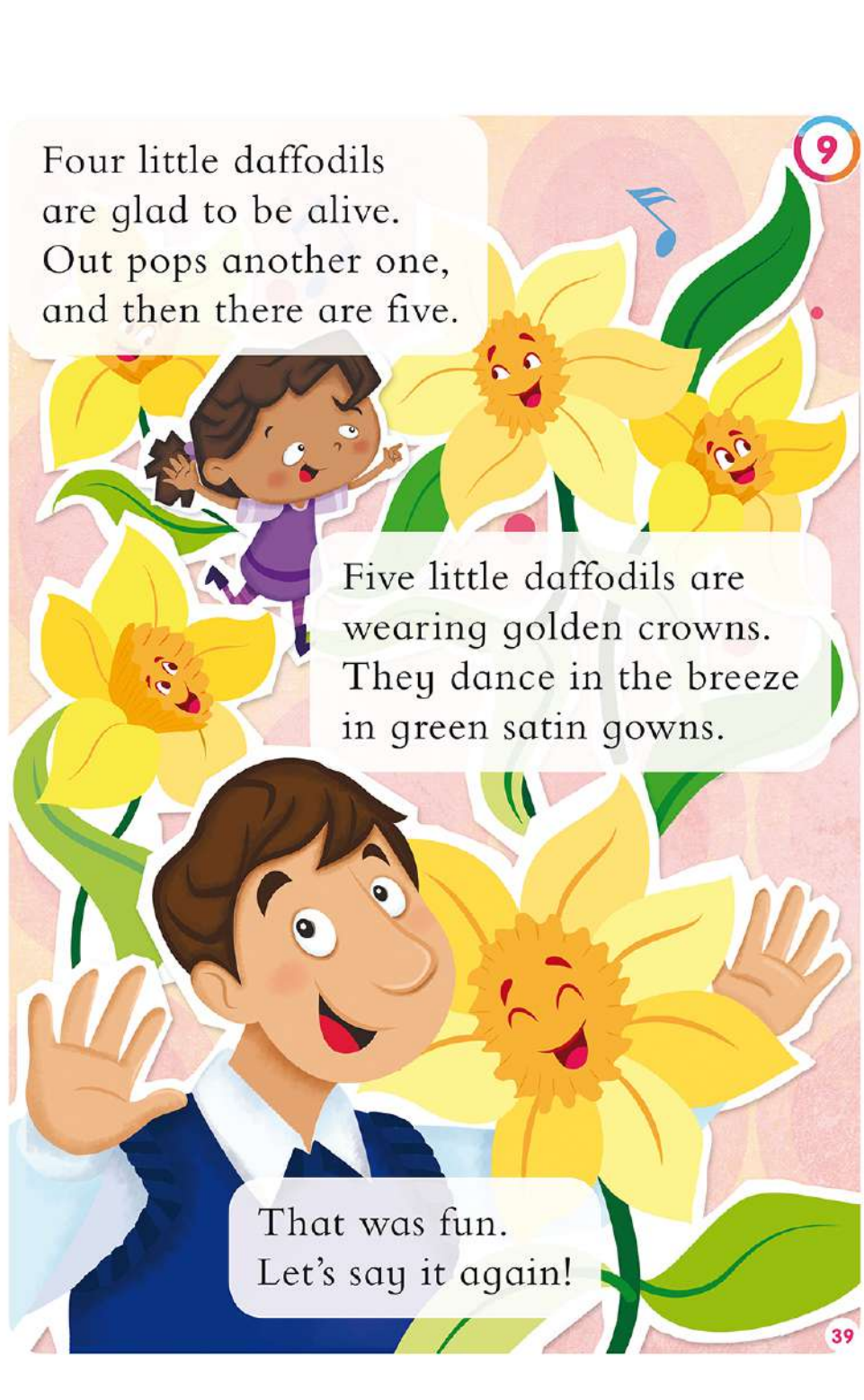
Two little daffodils are
