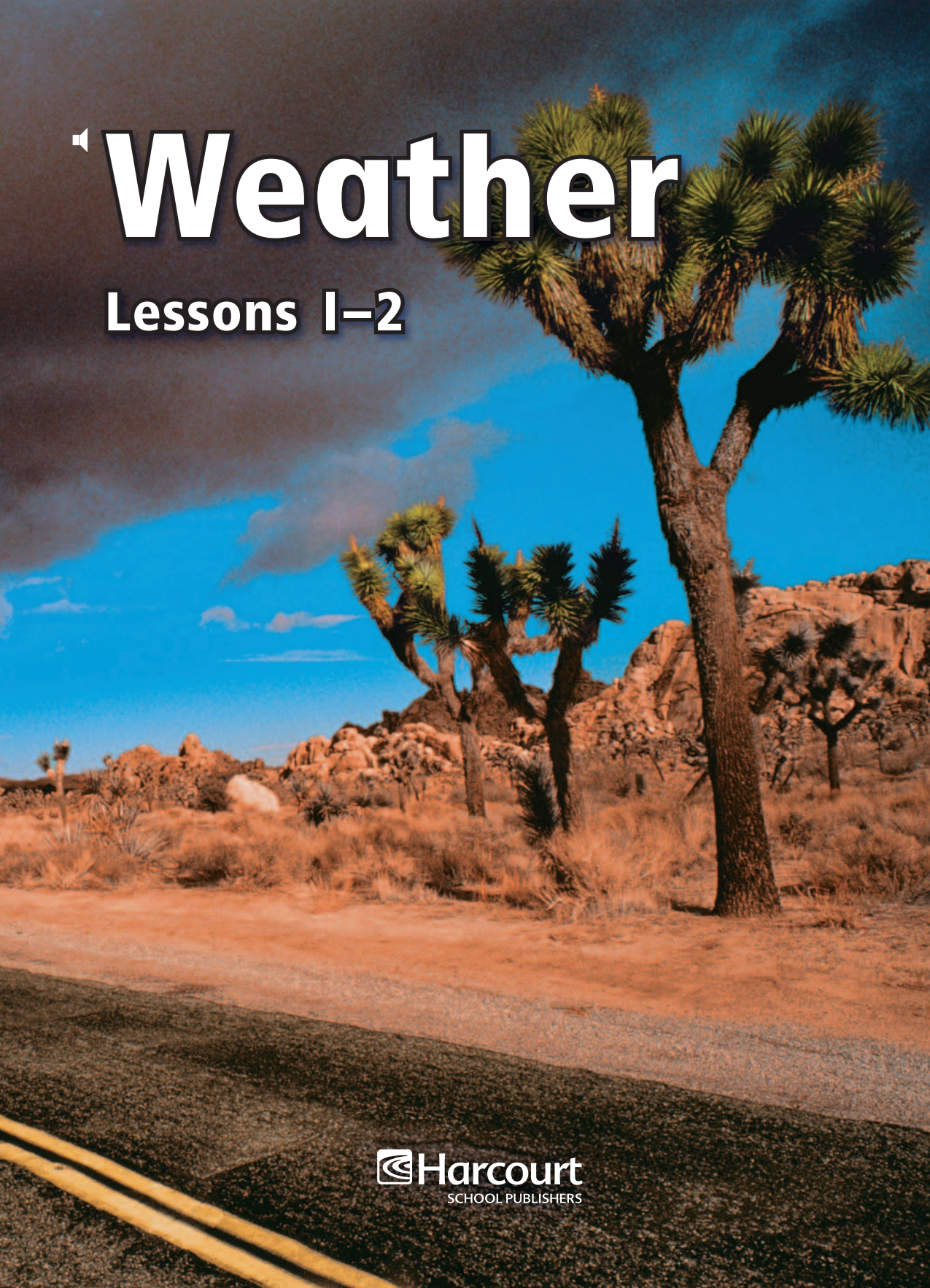

Predicting Weather



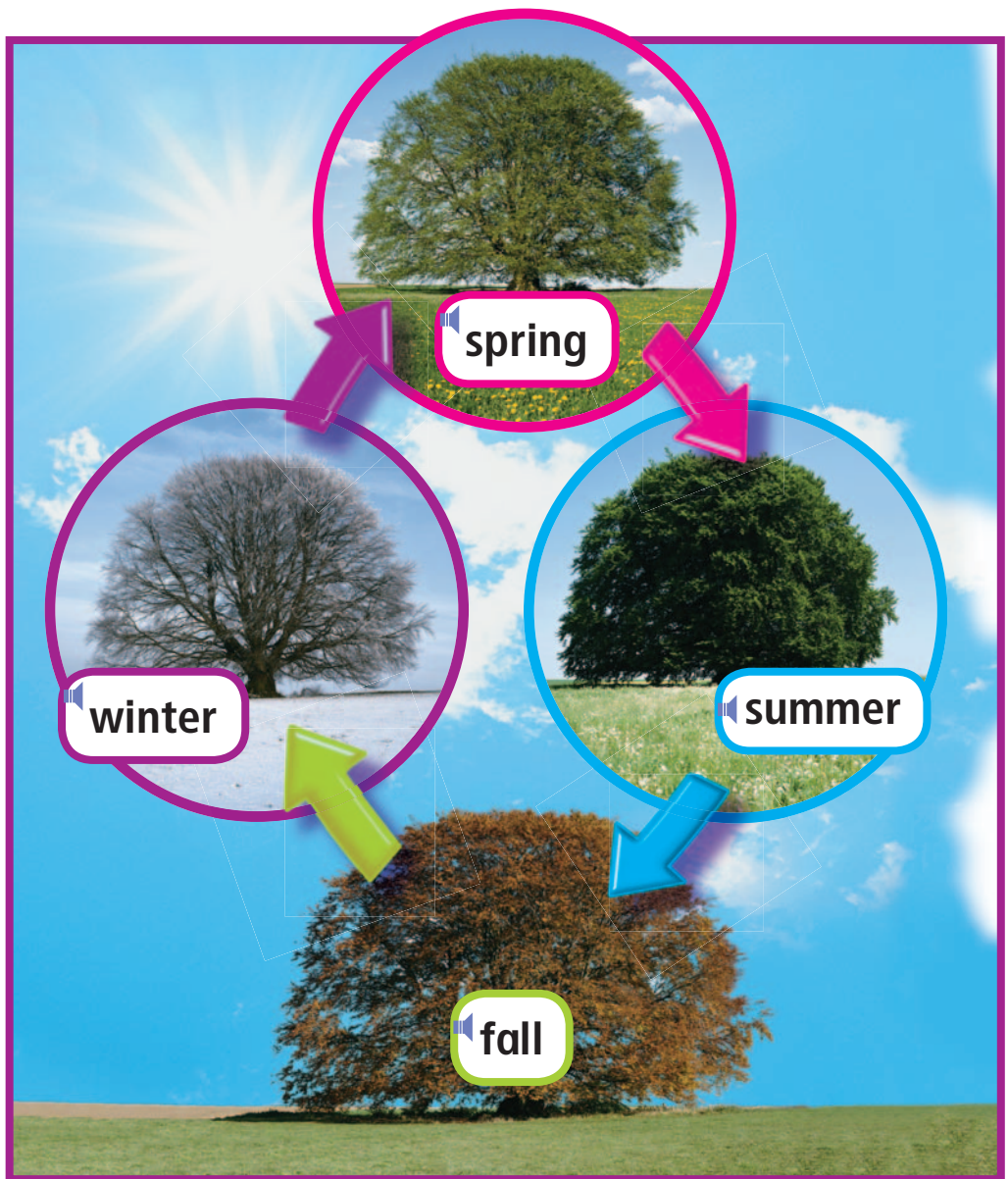
-  Weather may change from day to day.

- ▶ A change that repeats is a pattern.
- ▶ Patterns can help you predict weather.

Seasons

- ▶ A year has four seasons.
- ▶ The seasons form a pattern.





- Spring is a warm, rainy season.
- Summer weather is hot and sunny.

More Seasons



- In fall, the weather gets cool.
- Winter is the coldest season.



In winter, it snows
in some places.

- Spring comes again after winter.
- The pattern repeats each year.
