Alfie is from planet Alpha. He always has a lot of questions.



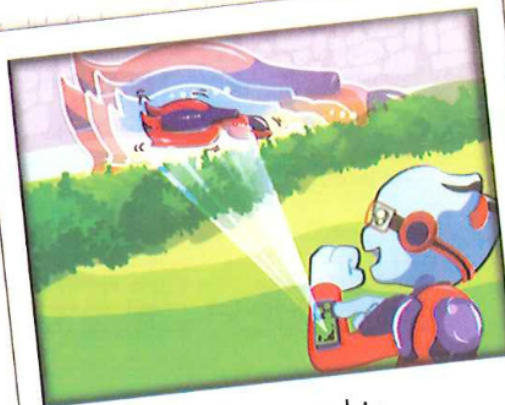
